





# Our topic today

- The topic of this webinar was chosen in light of the increasing prominence of circular economy on the EU policy agenda.
- In contrast to our economic model based on a 'take-make-consume-throw away' pattern, a circular economy requires fundamental changes to production and consumption systems, going far beyond resource efficiency and the recycling of waste.
- In the concept of the circular economy, preserving the value of products and materials for as long as possible within the economic system plays a central role, and it implies reducing waste to a minimum or zero.
- At the consumption side, products that are ideally designed for reuse, repair, refurbishment, and remanufacturing have to be supported by a shift towards sharing and leasing instead of selling and buying.
- Three countries will now present their approach to developing national circular economy policies and the way this process was organized.




- national targets for resource efficiency;
