



Sea cliffs in Macaronesia are rich in endemic species many of which are unique to a single island or group of islands.

Range & area reported as 'favourable' by both countries even though the trend is given as negative by both. However this does not alter the overall conclusion of 'unfavourable-inadequate' which is due to poor 'structure & function' (both countries) and 'future prospects' (only Spain) as a result of human impacts.

Pressures are mostly related to human impact.
