



Dunes with sea-buckthorn (*Hippophae rhamnoides*) are found around the coasts of the North Sea and the southern Baltic, plus a few sites in northern France and the northern Adriatic (Italy). In some areas sea buckthorn is an invasive alien species and considered a threat to other dune habitat types.

Assessed as 'unfavourable-inadequate' for both Atlantic and Continental regions, although considered 'favourable' in all countries except France and Italy and 'unknown' in Poland. It is possible that the reported area in France has been overestimated compared to other countries in the region so there is some doubt about the assessment for the Atlantic region.
