



Forests dominated by the mountain birch *Betula pubescens* ssp. *czerepanovii* occuring in the subalpine belt of the Scandinavian mountain range. In the northern part of their range they can also occur at lower altitudes. The character of the undergrowth varies depending on the soil type.

The conservation status in the Alpine region is 'favourable' and in the Boreal 'unfavourable inadequate'. The area of the habitat in Finland is decreasing. Although the major part of the habitat is included in the Natura 2000 network in this country, the habitat is threatened by overgrazing by reindeer and by climate change.
