



Forests dominated by Beech (Fagus sylvatica) or in the northern Balkan peninsula by Fagus moesiaca, with a more thermophile character than the beechwoods of habitat type 9270 or its northern equivalent 91W0 (only present in Bulgaria within the European Union although possibly present in Greece). The habitat occurs at mid altitude in the mountains.

This habitat is present only in the Mediterranean region in Greece and Italy. The conservation status is 'favourable' and no major threats were reported.
