



Communities dominated by arborescent holly (*Ilex aquifolium*). These woods correspond to the senescence stage of a forest with an understory of yew (*Taxus baccata*) and holly after the dissapearance of the tree layer. They occur in the mountains of the Mediterranean basin and in northern Spain on various soil types.

The conservation status in the Atlantic region is 'unknown' due to the very incomplete report from Spain and in the Mediterranean 'favourable'. Assessed as 'favourable' in all the countries where present in the Mediterranean region except Portugal, where the status of the habitat is 'unfavourable-inadequate' and Spain where it is 'unknown'.

Better information required from Spain.
