



Forests dominated by the evergreen golden oak (Quercus alnifolia) growing on basic volcanic soils of the Troodos mountains of Cyprus. This habitat type also includes mattorals derived from these forests.

The habitat is endemic to Cyprus. The conservation status is 'favourable' and no major threats were reported.
