



Heaths with Cornish heath (*Erica vagans*) occur along the Atlantic coast of northern Spain and rarely in western France and south west England. This habitat is a priority subtype of habitat type 4030.

Assessed as 'unknown' as Spain, which has some 90% of the habitat area reported all parameters as 'unknown'. Reported as 'unfavourable-inadequate' by France and 'favourable' by the United Kingdom where this habitat is restricted to a single locality. Better information required from Spain.
