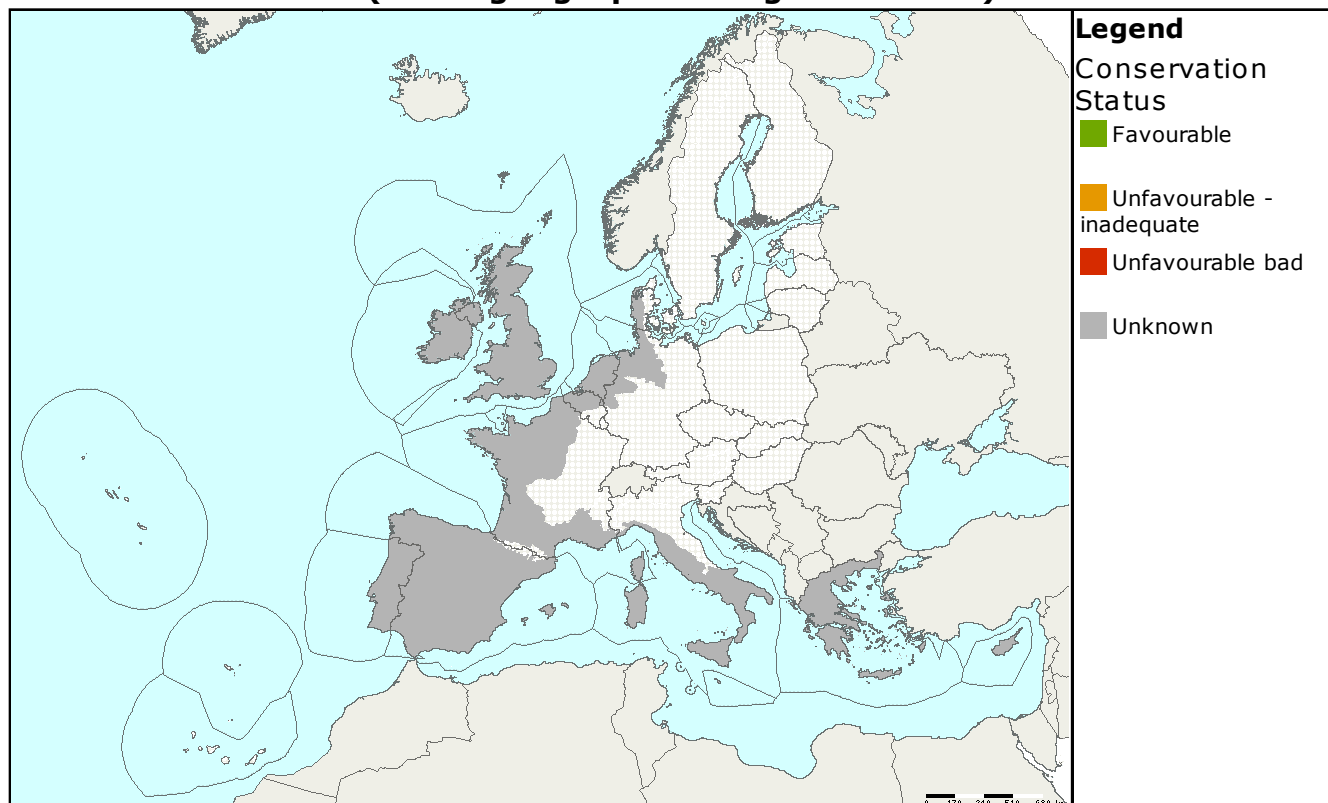

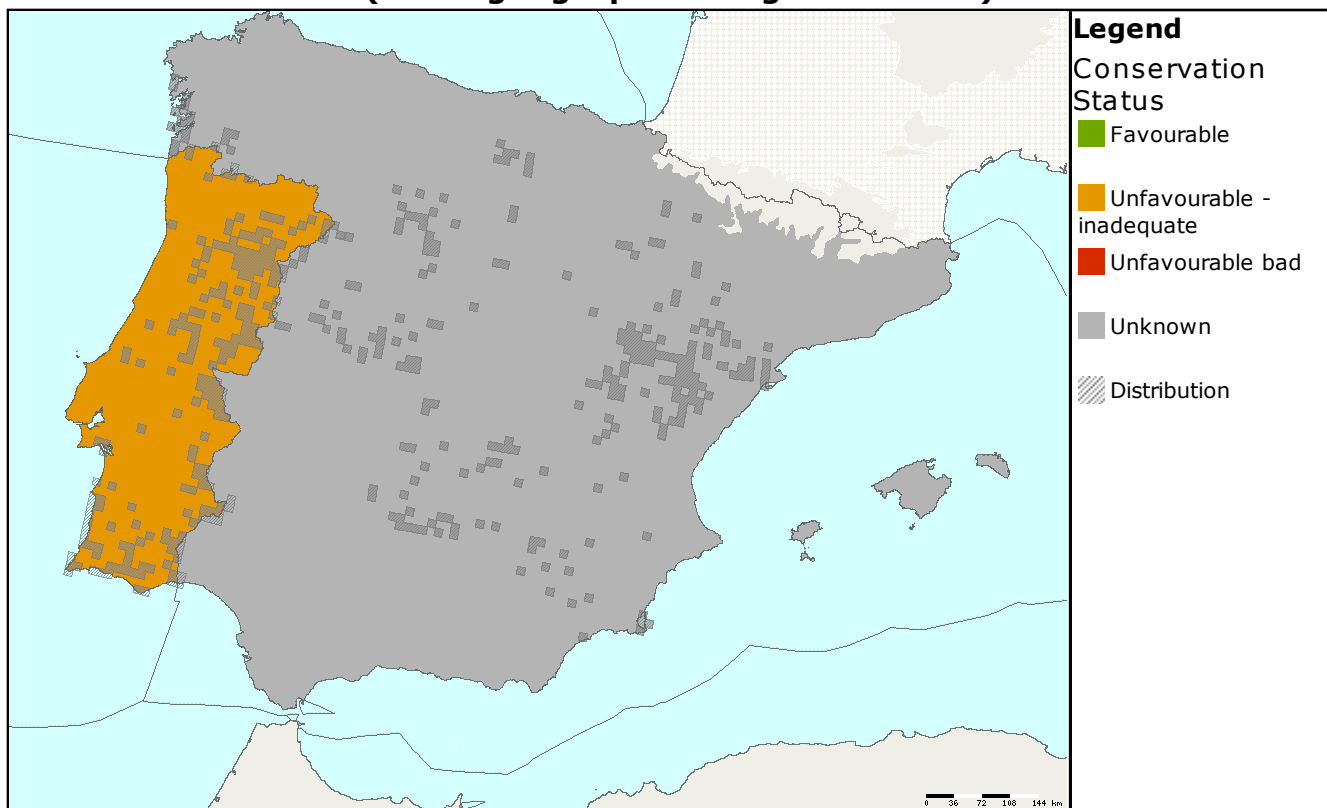

The Spanish Cylindrical Skink is a species with natural distribution scattered all across the Iberian Peninsula except its most northern part. It occurs mainly in the areas with a Mediterranean type of climate, on rocks, rocky slopes or sand dunes with open vegetation.

The conservation status in both the Mediterranean and the Atlantic biogeographical regions is 'unknown'; the information about the actual parameters of the conservations status is not available or is scarce. Anyway, it is possible to conclude that the conservation status in the Mediterranean biogeographical region is not 'favourable' considering 'unfavourable inadequate' status of the population in Portugal. In general, the populations of Spanish Cylindrical Skink are small and isolated. Furthermore its habitats

are endangered by inappropriate forestry practices. In Spain it is listed in the Red Data Book in the category near threatened.
