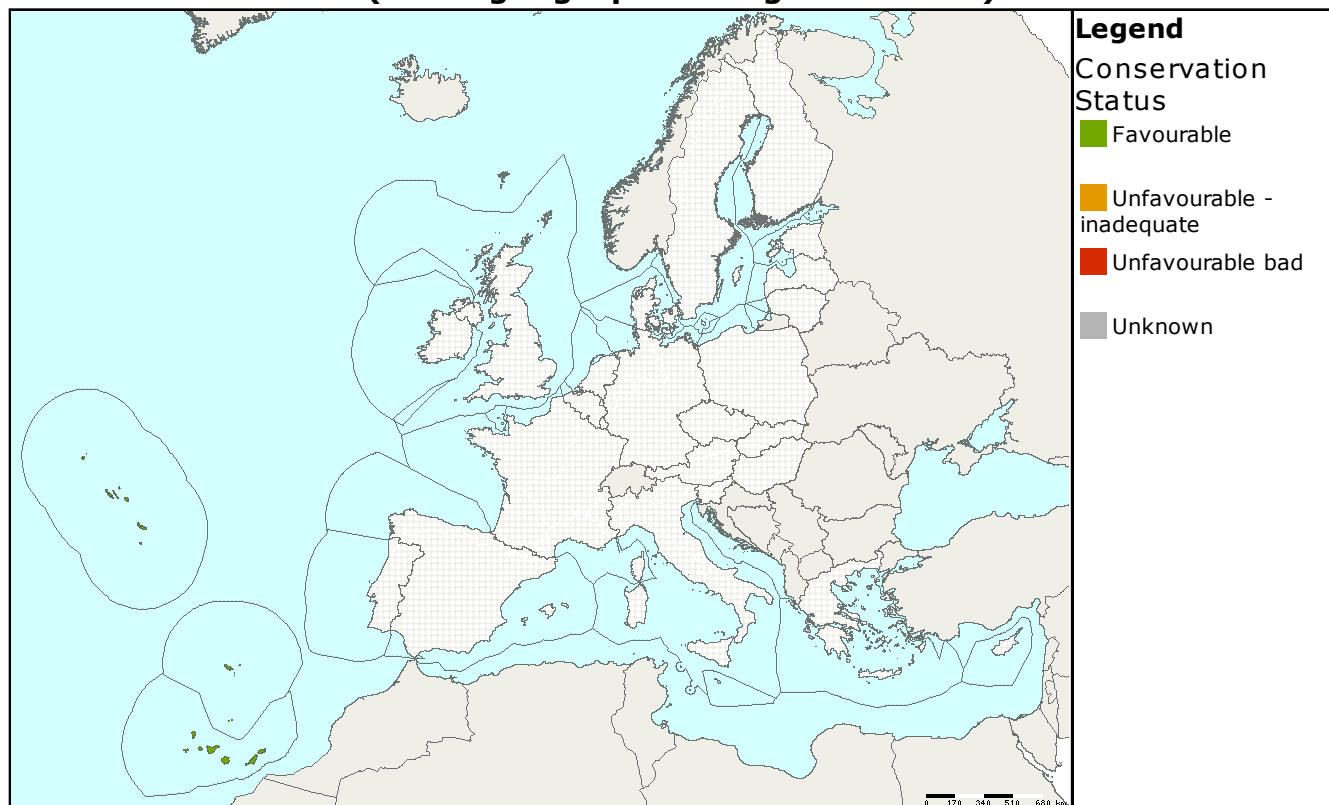

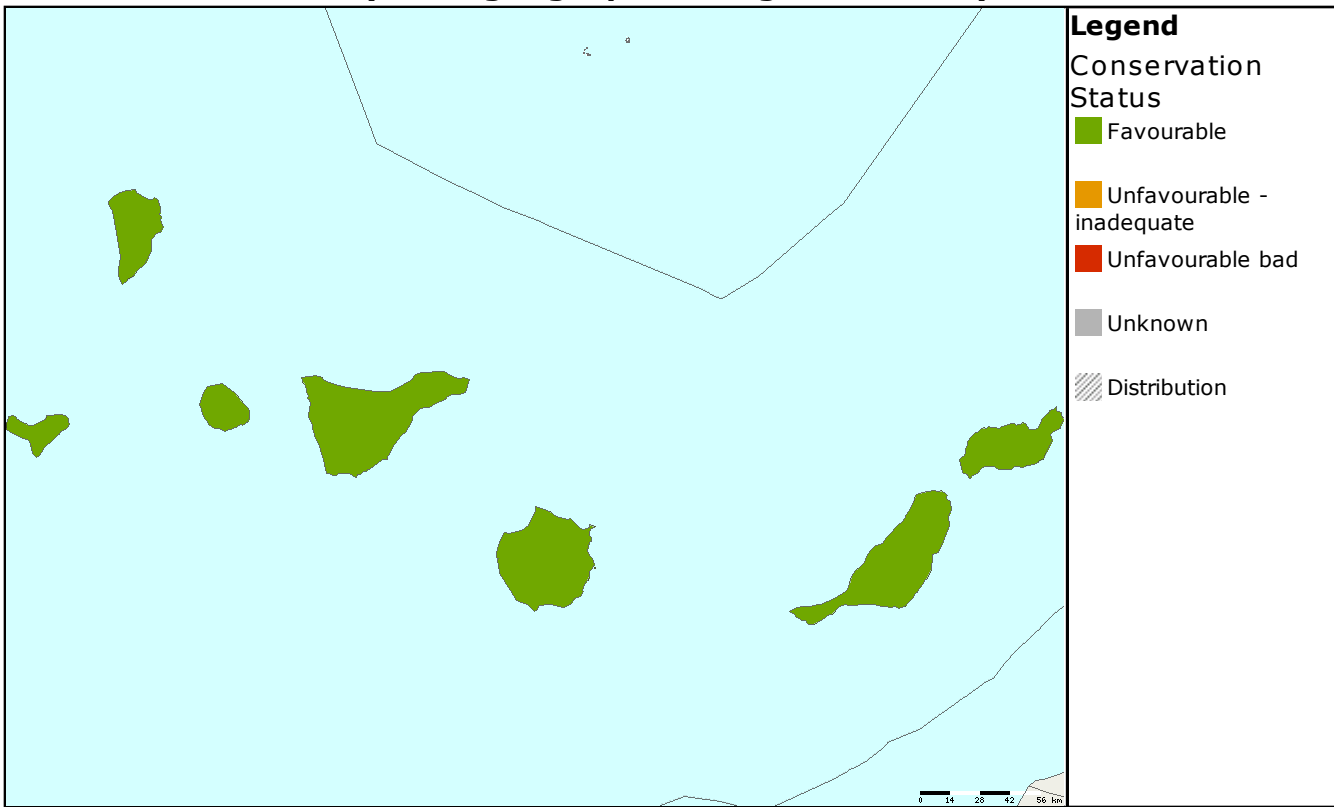

A lizard endemic to Gran Canaria, Spain. It inhabits various types of natural, semi-natural and man made habitats. Although only found on one island it is abundant within its range.

The conservation status is 'favourable'. No major threats were recorded. The species is evaluated as 'least concern' in 2008 IUCN Red List.
