



A lizard endemic to the islands of Fuerteventura, Lanzarote, and Lobos in the Canary Islands, Spain. It can be found in various types of natural and secondary habitats, including orchards, gardens or rocky slopes.

The conservation status was assessed as 'unfavourable inadequate' due to the assessment of the habitat of species, the other parameters are 'unknown'. The species is included in 2008 IUCN Red List as 'endangered'. It is considered to be on decline in recent years; however this might be caused by the absence of comprehensive research.
