



The natural range of Dahls whip snake spreads from south-eastern Europe through Asia Minor to Caucasus region. Within the EU it is known from Greece and Bulgaria, few specimens have been found in Cyprus.

The conservation status in the Mediterranean biogeographical region in Greece is `unknown'. No major threats are known and the species is not considered particularly endangered there.
