



The Kotschy's gecko is found on coasts in the eastern Mediterranean, many subspecies (at least 25) have been described. Besides Greece, Cyprus and Italy, it is also reported from Bulgaria. Beyond the European Union it is known from Albania, FYROM, Turkey and further east. Species is poorly known leading to incomplete reports by Cyprus and Greece and assessed as 'unknown'. Better information required.
