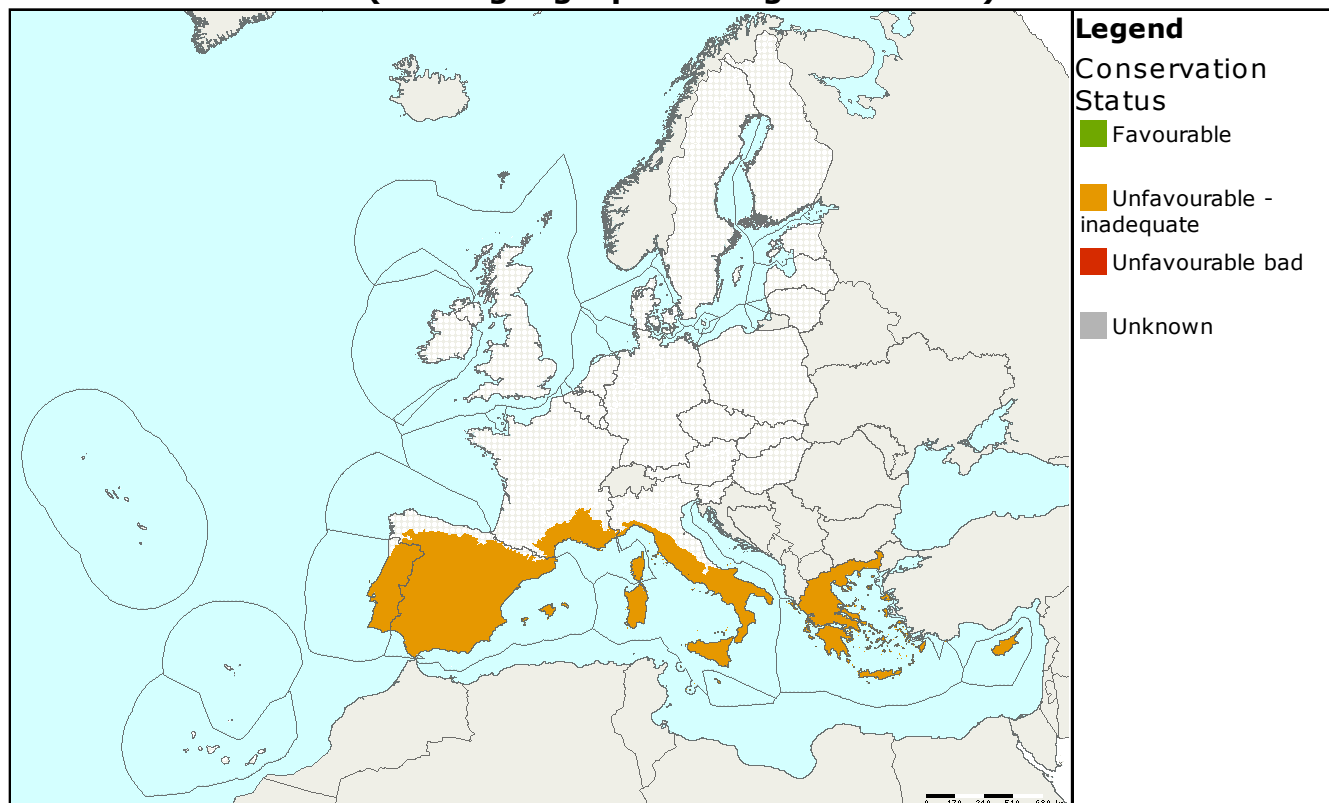

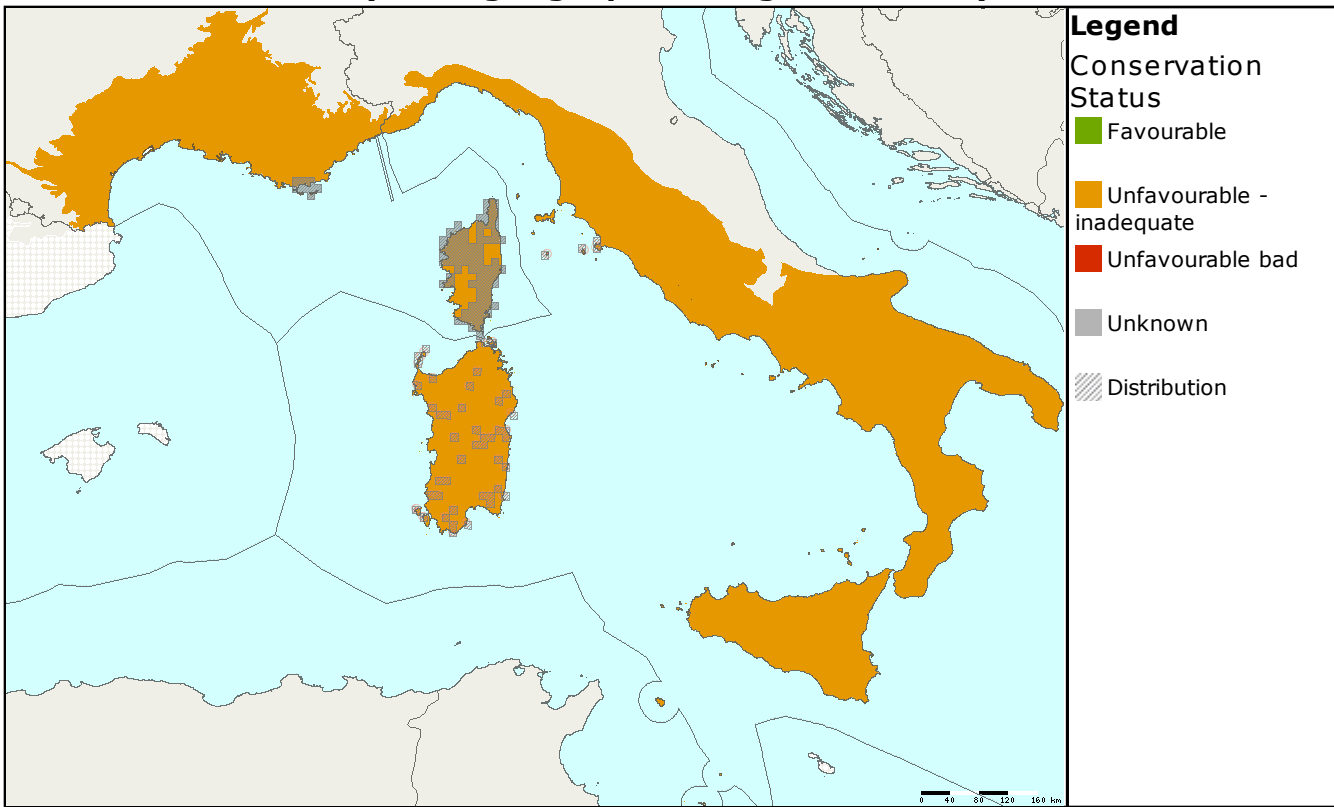

The Tyrrhenian painted frog is native to mostly islands of France and Italy (main populations are on Corsica and Sardinia). The species inhabits a wide range of aquatic and terrestrial habitats including still and slow-running waters in open or wooded (coniferous and broadleaf) areas. This species is evaluated in all parameters and by both countries as 'unfavourable-inadequate' and overall assessment is the same. According to IUCN Red List it is considered as 'least concern'.
