



The leopard snake is reported in Mediterranean region by Greece, Italy and Malta. This species is widespread and relatively common in all countries. Overall assessment is 'unknown' influenced by Greek report (biggest range). Situation is reported 'favourable' by other countries. According to IUCN assessment, it is considered as 'least concern'.
