



A lizard species, which is relatively common in Turkey and on western Aegean Greek islands. It inhabits rocky slopes with open Mediterranean forests, grasslands or orchards.

It occurs only in the Mediterranean biogeographical region where the conservation status is 'unknown'. This insufficiently known species is considered to be declining on the island of Rhodes, but on the other hand it is relatively abundant in other islands. Better information is required.
