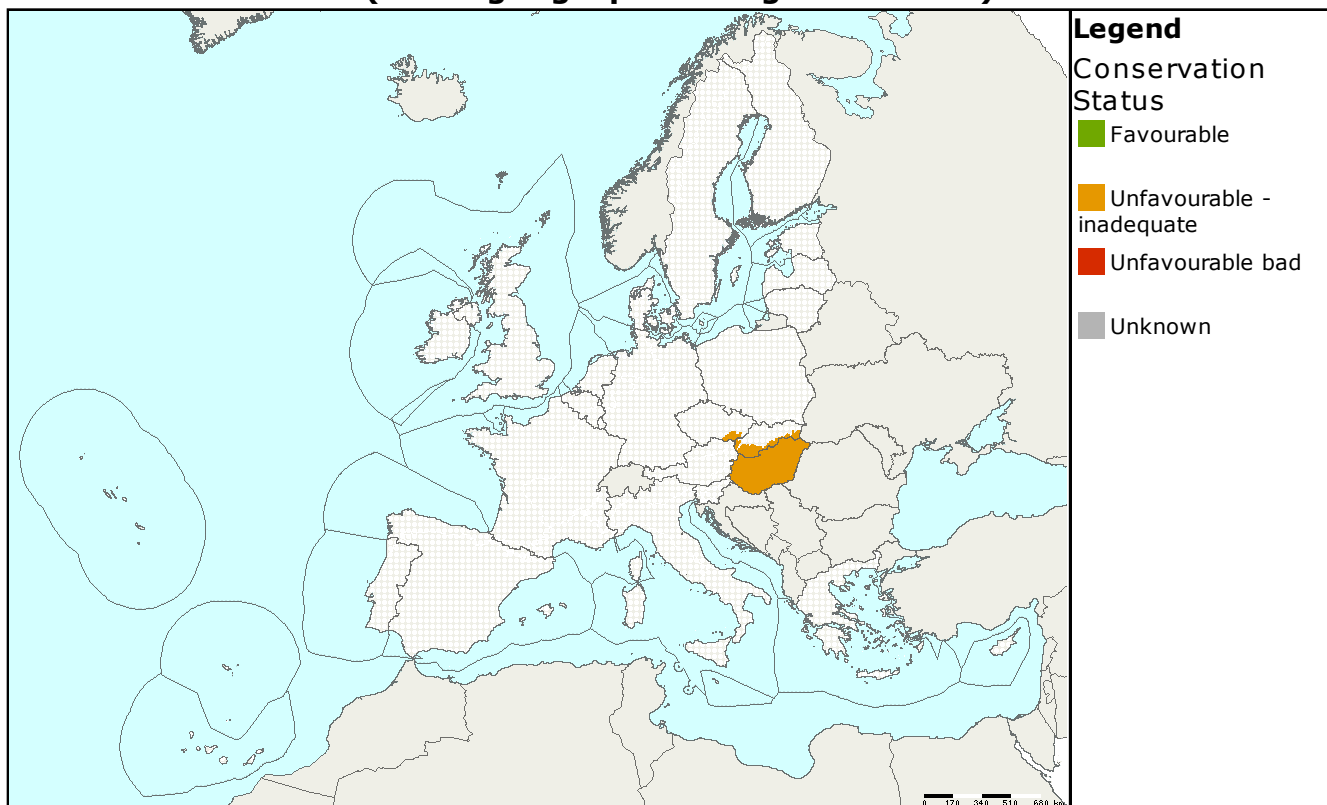

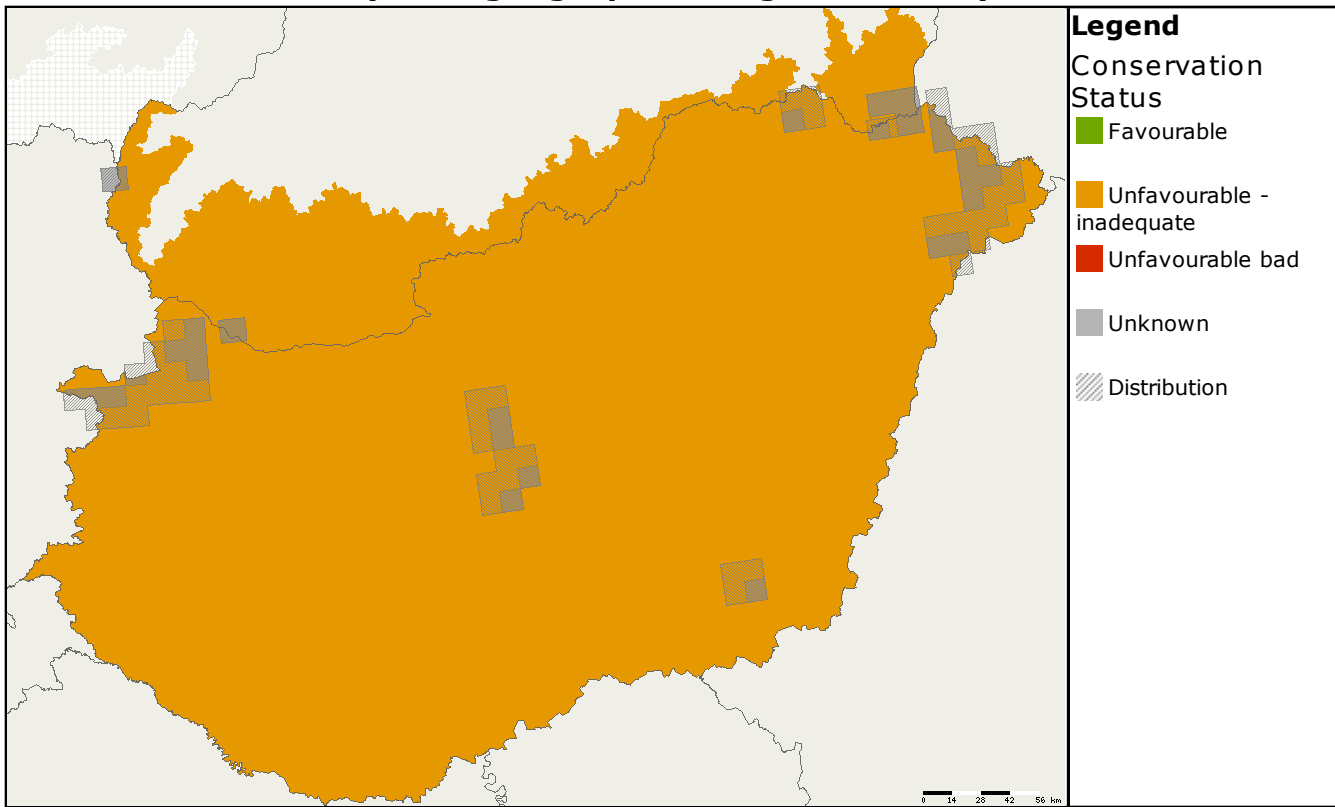

*Lacerta vivipara pannonica* is a subspecies of the common lizard reported from Pannonian biogeographical region by Hungary and Slovakia. The overall assessment is 'unfavourable-inadequate', the same as reported by both countries. General problem is data deficiency.
