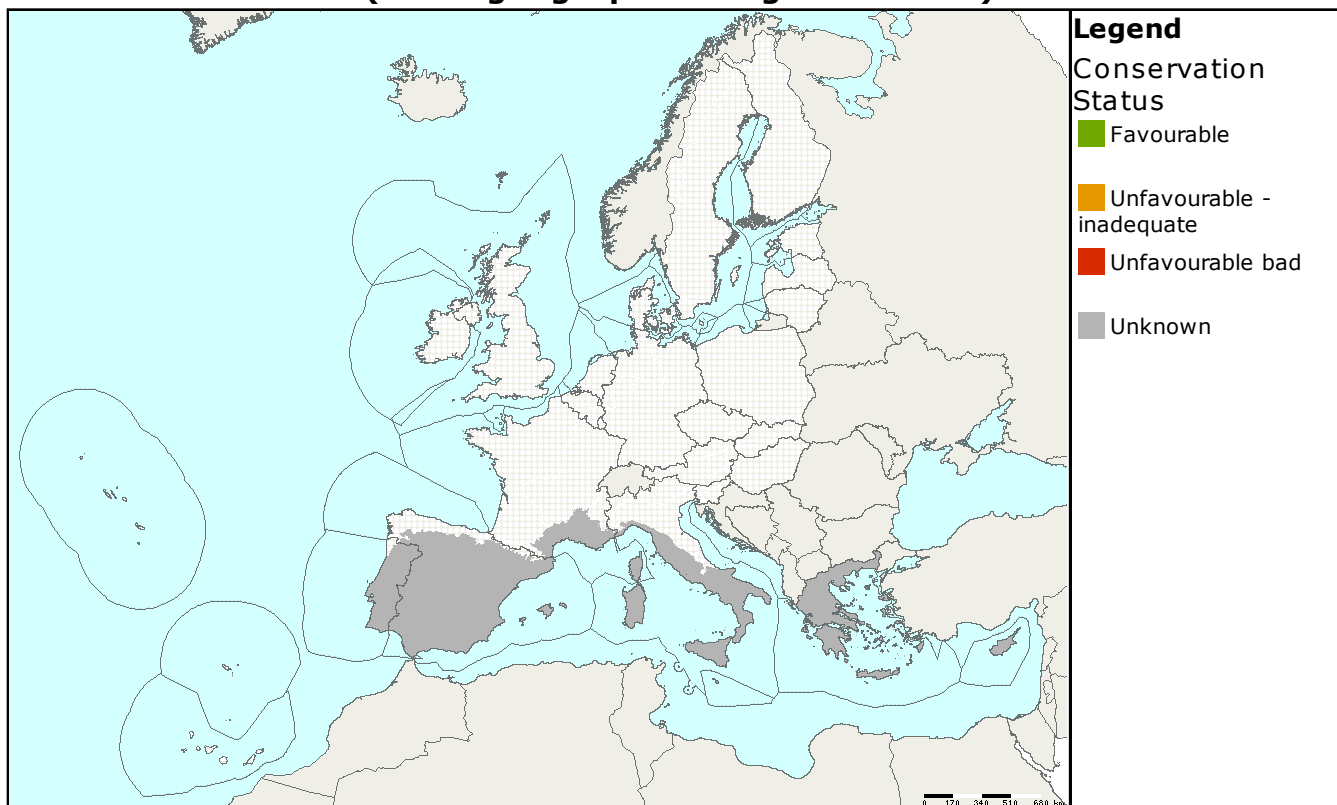

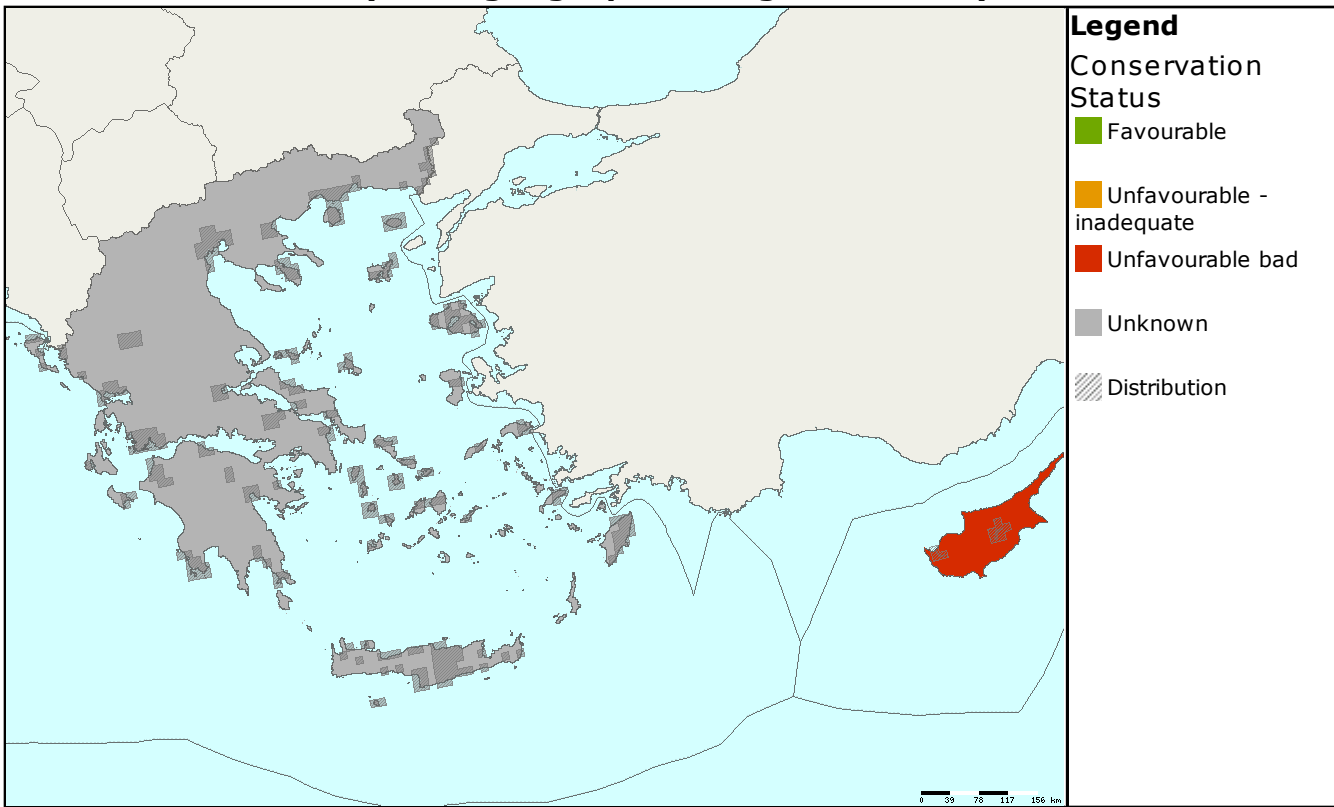

The Caspian terrapin is reported from the Mediterranean region in Cyprus and Greece even if the species is expected to occur in more areas. Its overall status of conservation is assessed as "unknown", showing that better information is required for the species.
