



A subspecies of the Grass Snake endemic to Sardinia, where it is very rare. It is associated with an aquatic environment, and it preferably occurs in mountainous areas.

The conservations status of this snake is 'unknown'. The information on status of population, on status of range and on the potential threats is not available or is scarce. The subspecies is considered 'endangered' in Italy.
