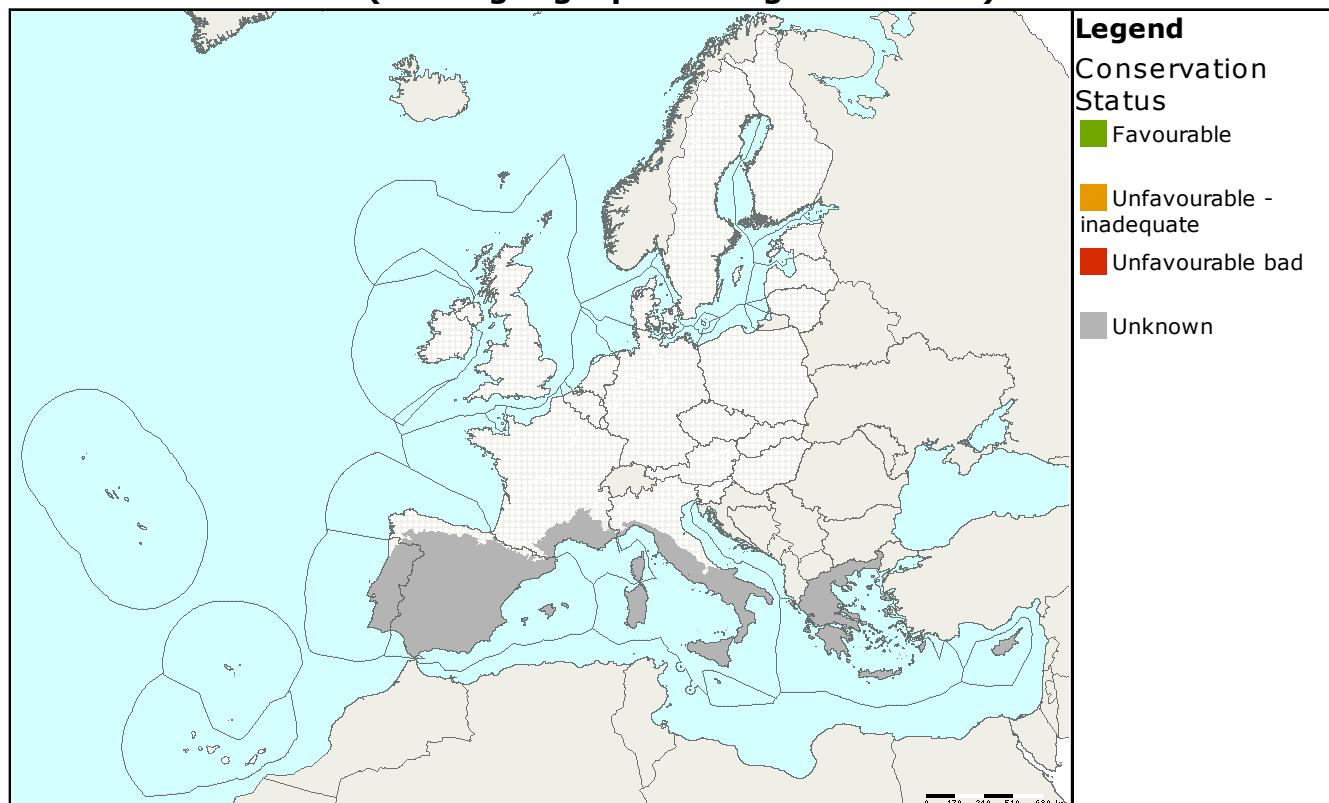

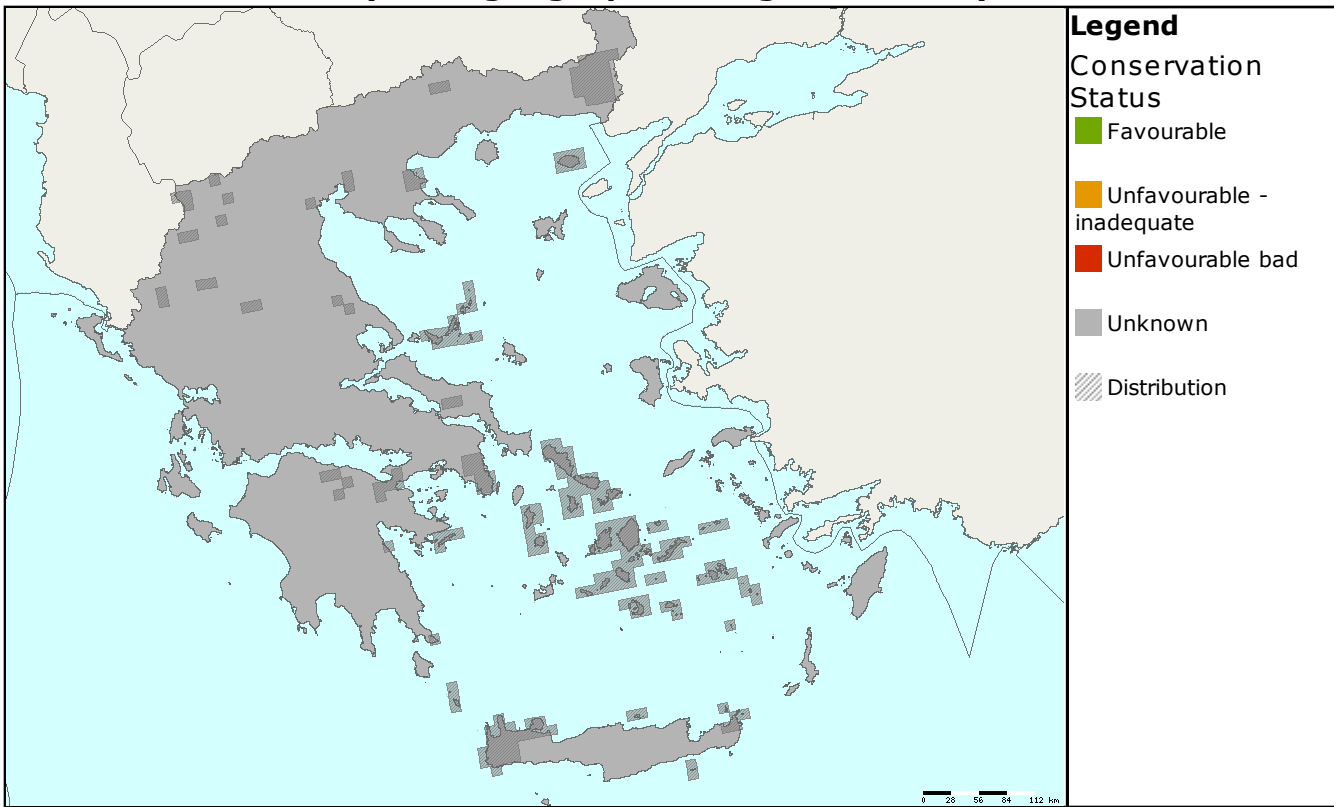

The Erhard's Wall Lizard ranges from southern Bulgaria and Serbia to Greek Aegean islands. It is endemic to the Balkan Peninsula. It can be found in a variety of Mediterranean habitats linked to dry rocky slopes.

It was reported only from the Mediterranean biogeographical region. The conservation status is 'unknown'. The information on the status of this species and on the threats is scarce.
