



The Italian stream frog is an endemic species to the Apennine Mountains and other hilly areas of Italy south of the Po Valley. The species is only reported by Italy. For the Alpine region its status of conservation is "unfavourable-inadequate"; for the continental region the overall assessment is "unknown" and "favourable" for the Mediterranean region. Many individual parameters are reported as "unknown" showing better information is required for the species. Listed as "Least Concern" by IUCN in view of its wide distribution.
