

The Southern Crested Newt ranges from the Eastern Balkan through the Northern Aegean coast and the Black Sea coast of Turkey to the Caucasus region. Within the EU it also occurs in Bulgaria. It inhabits mountainous forested areas. It breeds in small pools or streams.

It was reported only from the Mediterranean biogeographical region. The conservation status is 'unfavourable bad'; the range and the population size are decreasing and both are much lower than favourable, in some areas the habitats of species were destroyed.
