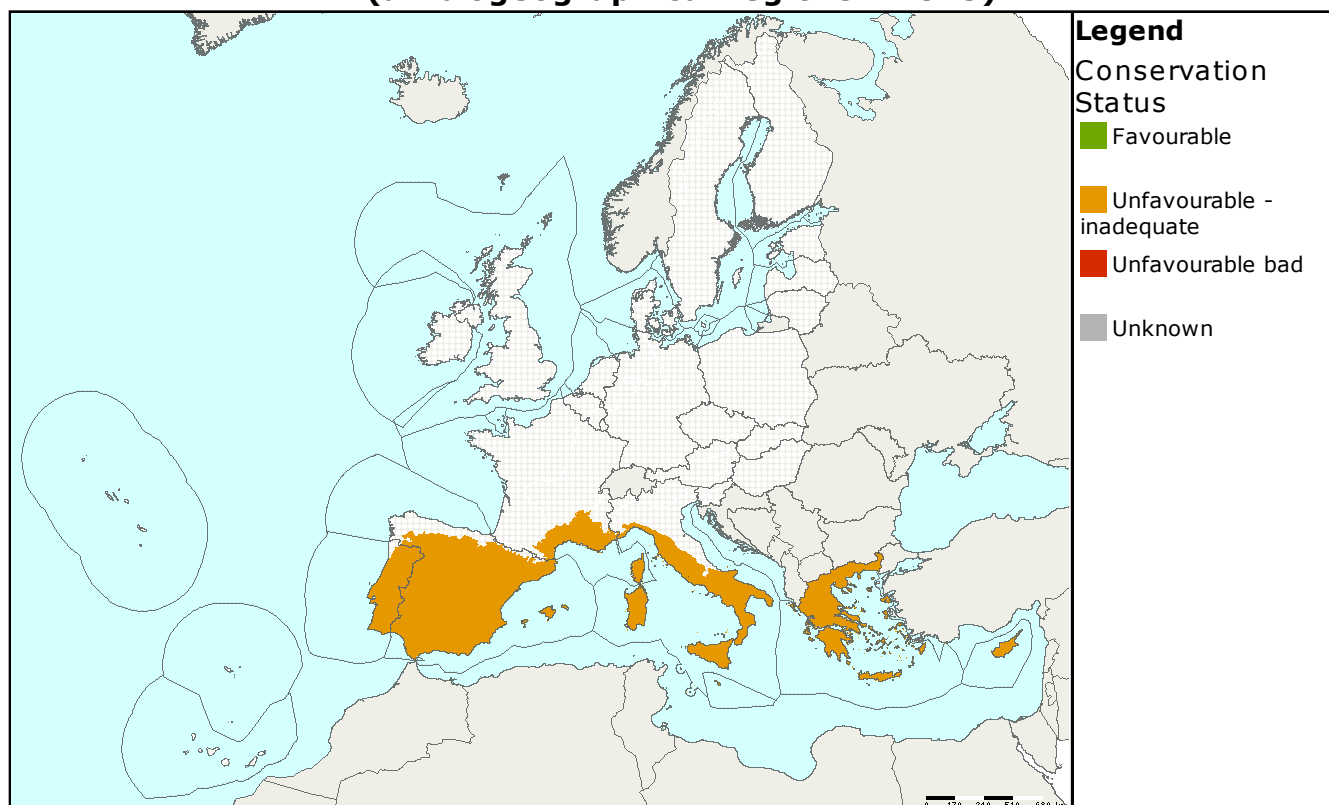

MED: The Greek authorities assessed the conservation status of the Macedonian Shad as 'favourable' in the Mediterranean region. This is a freshwater species currently restricted to Lake Volvi. However, the species disappeared in 1995 from Lake Koronia and it may be vulnerable in Lake Volvi because of alien species, water extraction and eutrophication (see IUCN <http://www.iucnredlist.org/search/details.php/905/summ>). Therefore, we conclude that conservation status is not favourable, most probably 'unfavourable-inadequate'.
