



MED: Species is reported from Mediterranean biogeographical region only from EL. Its overall assessment is 'favourable'. However, the IUCN 2007 Red-List reports the following threats: habitat destruction, water pollution, and overfishing; this may indicate at least 'poor future prospects' and lead to an 'unfavourable-inadequate' conservation status.
