



ATL: The pollan (Coregonus autumnalis) is confined in W. Europe to a series of large lakes on the island of Ireland. Species were described in the literature as C. autumnalis pollan Thompson (1856). The currently accepted classification is simply C. autumnalis Pallas 1776." The species does not have a defined Natura2000 code and does not correspond with Coregonus autumnalis autumnalis (Natura 2000 code 5053). There are 3 populations of pollan in the Republic of Ireland, their size is unknown but variously estimated as 1% of fish biomass in the relevant lakes and hundreds – low thousands per lake. Its overall assessment is "bad" because state of its populations was evaluated as "bad".
