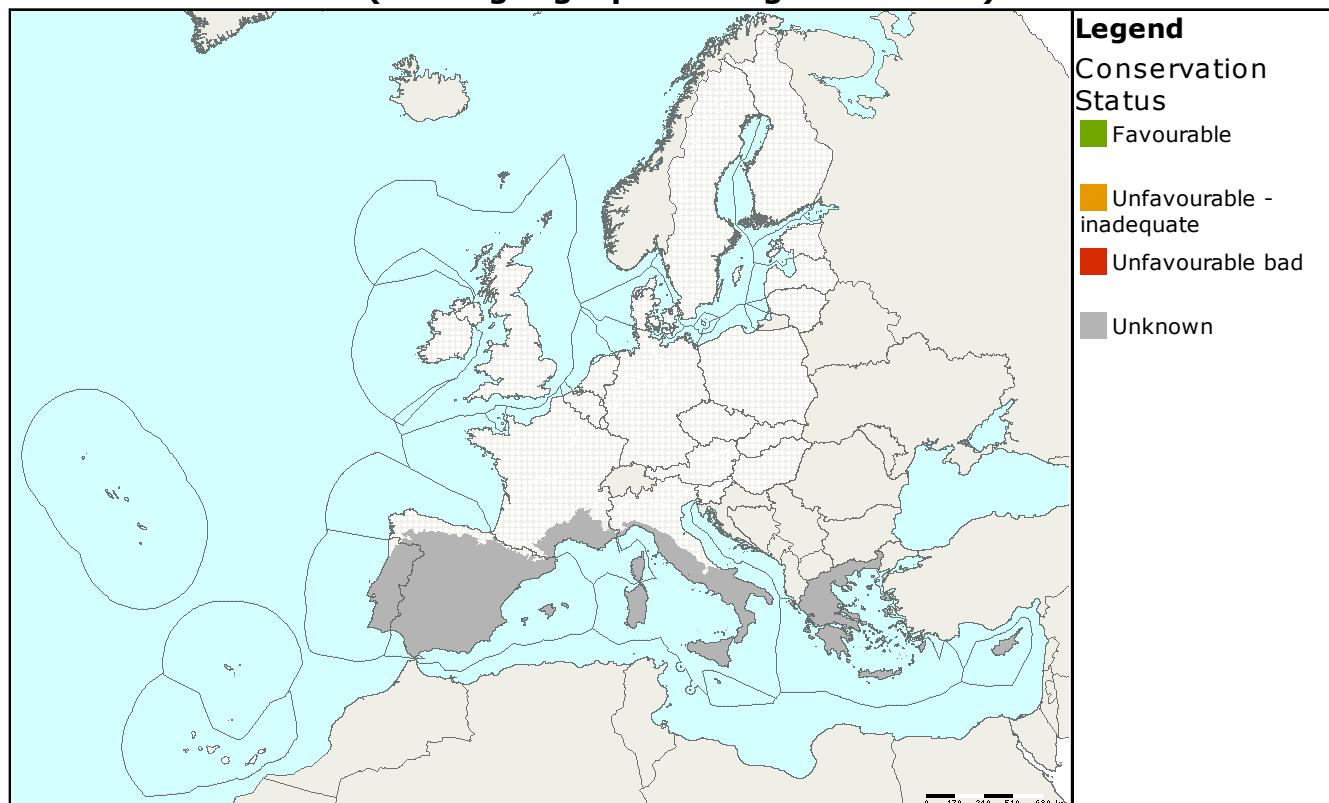

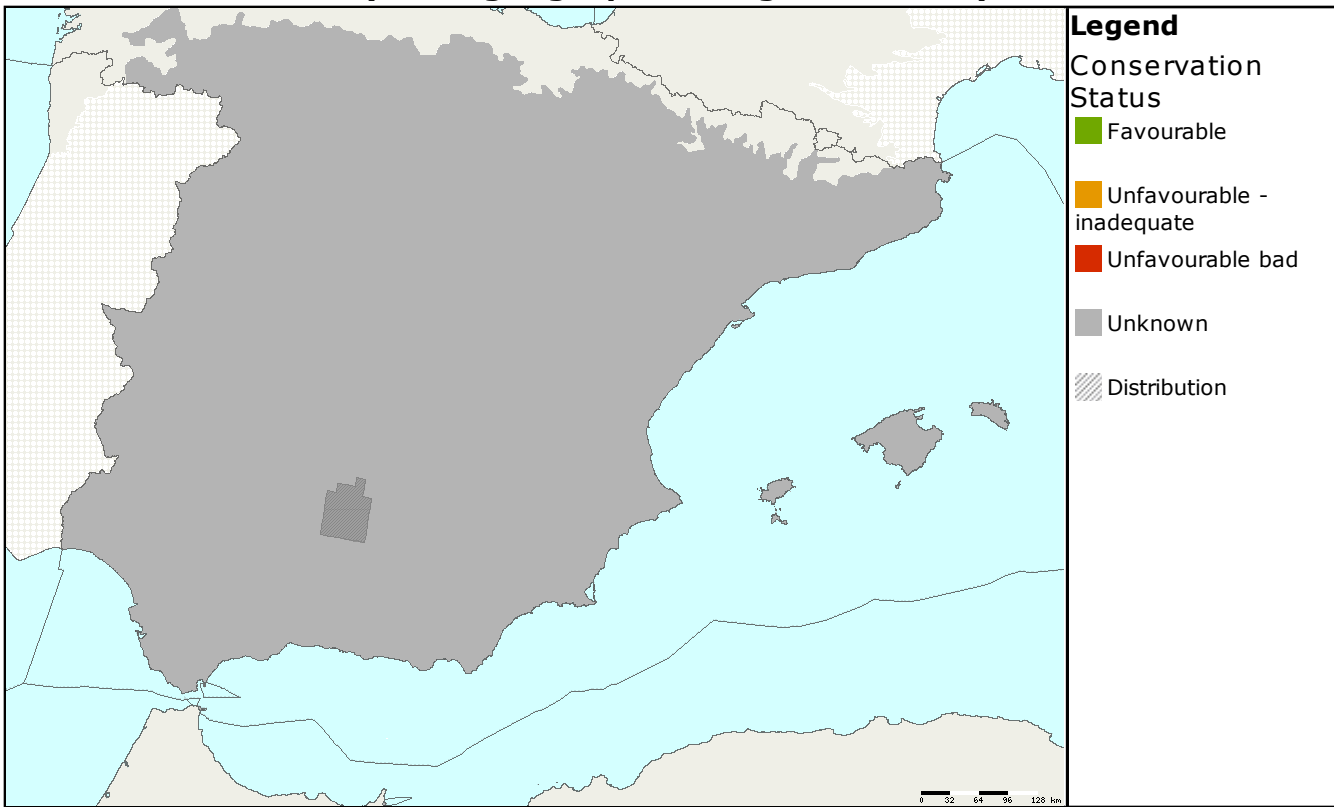

MED: This small carp is restricted to the Guadalquivir river basin in Spain (river Guadalquivir and tributaries Rumber and Jandula). Its conservation status is 'unknown'. However, it is classified as Critically Endangered in the 2007 IUCN Red List (<http://www.iucnredlist.org/search/details.php/60375/summ>). Current valid scientific names is *Squalius palaciosi* (Doadrio, 1980).
