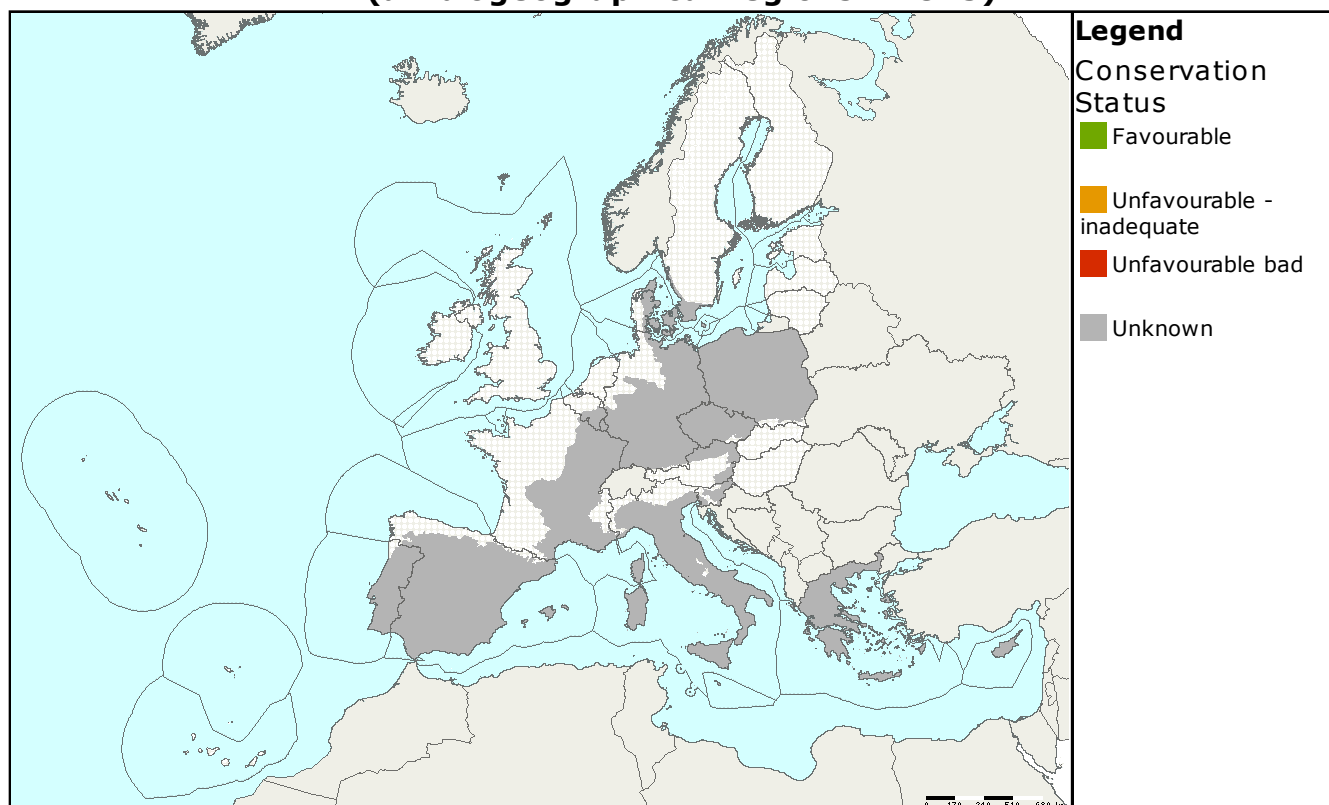

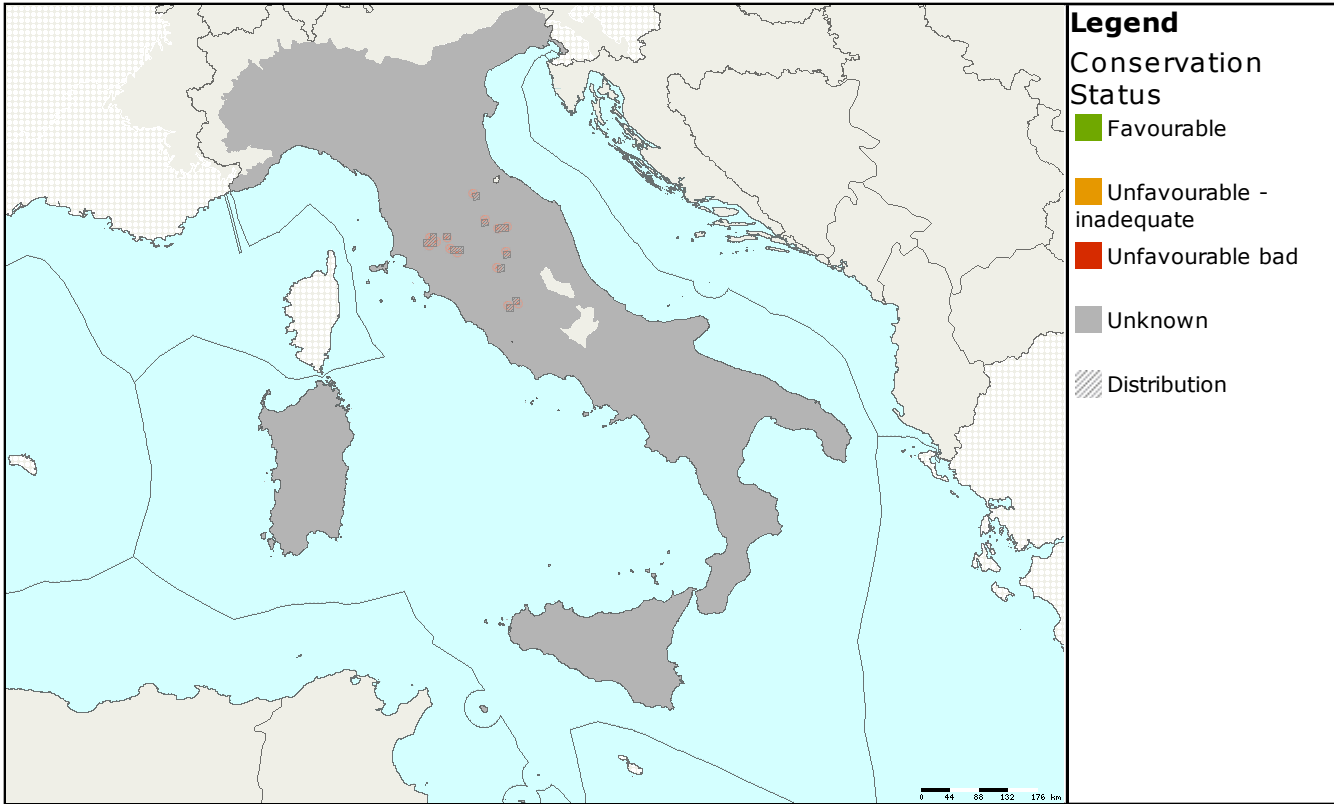

A freshwater fish species endemic to 3 river basins in Tuscany-Latium region of Italy. However the taxonomic status of the species is not clear and the research is carried out on this subject. It is a riverine species occurring in brooks and small rivers.

The conservation status of the species in both the Continental and the Mediterranean biogeographical regions is 'unknown'; the reports provided by Italy are incomplete. According to the 2008 IUCN Red List, the species is 'endangered'. It occurs in very limited area, which is together with the population size decreasing. Species is threatened mainly due to negative interactions with introduced fish.
