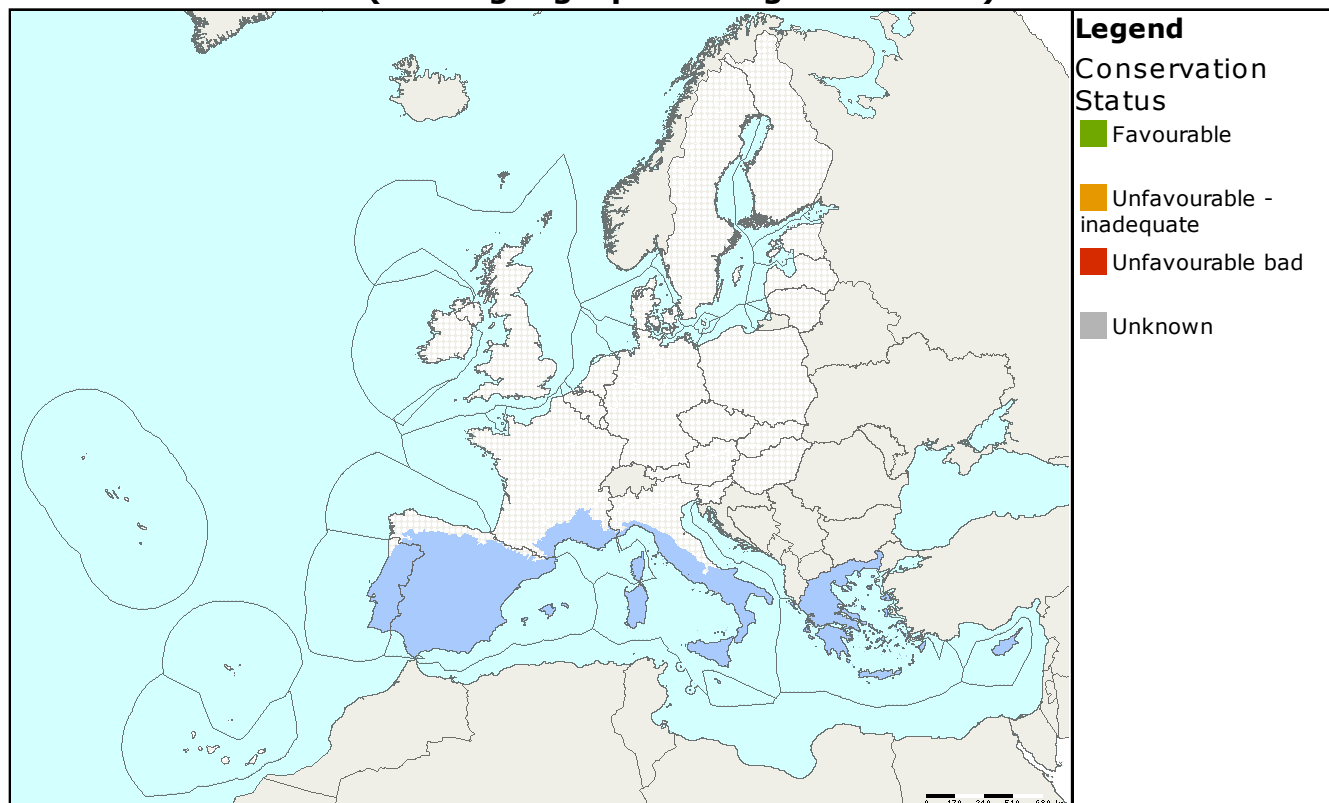

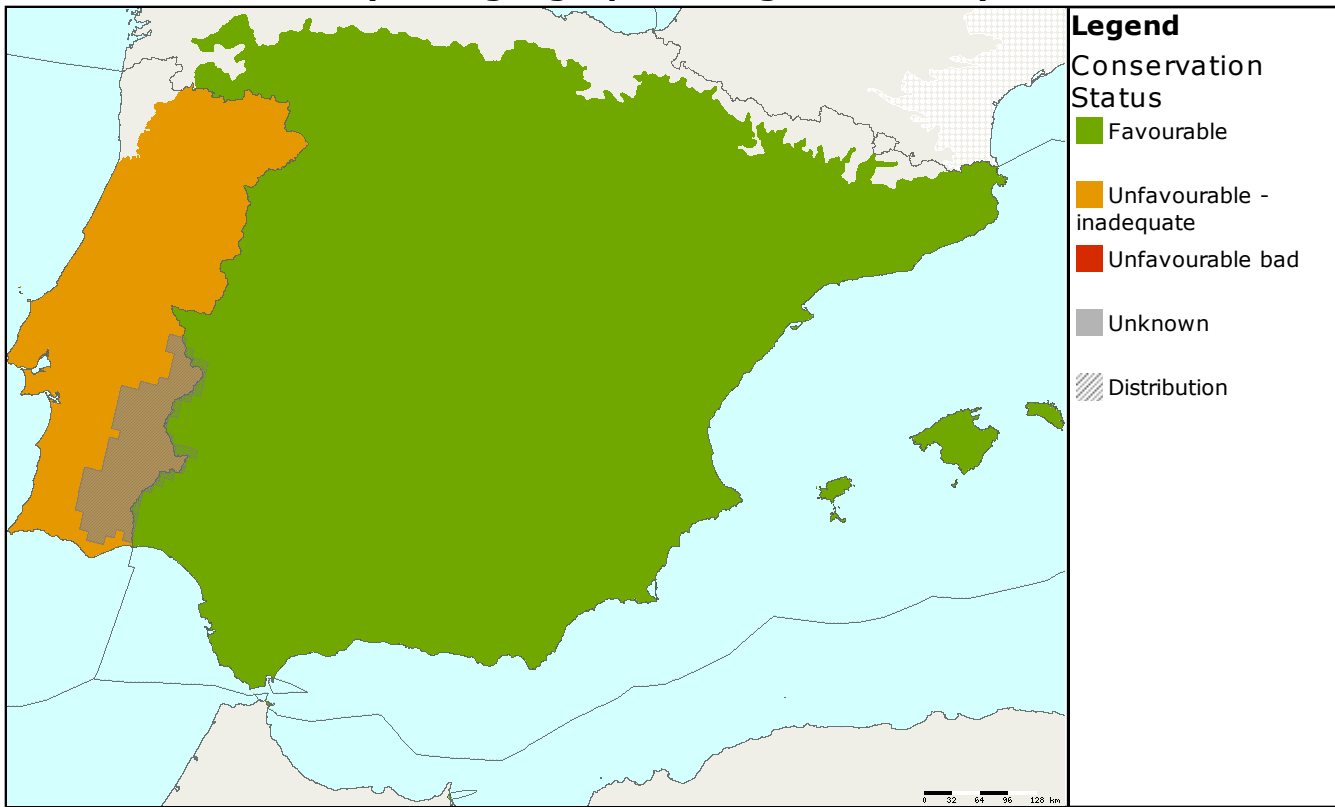

Barbus microcephalus is a freshwater fish species reported from Mediterranean biogeographical region from Spain and Portugal. There are no available data on its range, population and distribution in Spain and therefore overall assessment is not possible. The distribution map in the Spanish Red data book for fish suggests a similar area for distribution and range in both countries which suggests an overall conclusion of 'unfavourable-inadequate'. Better information required from Spain. It is classified as 'vulnerable' according to IUCN Red List.
