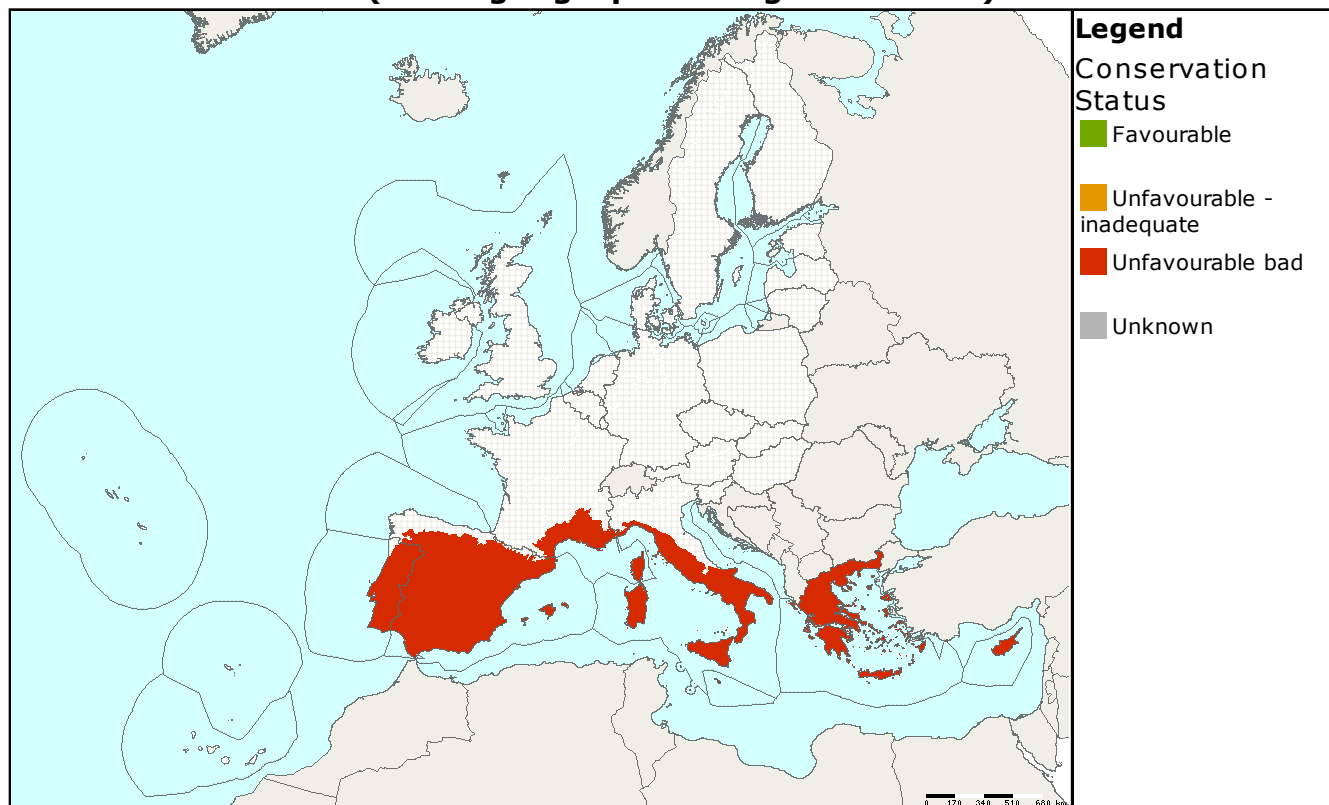

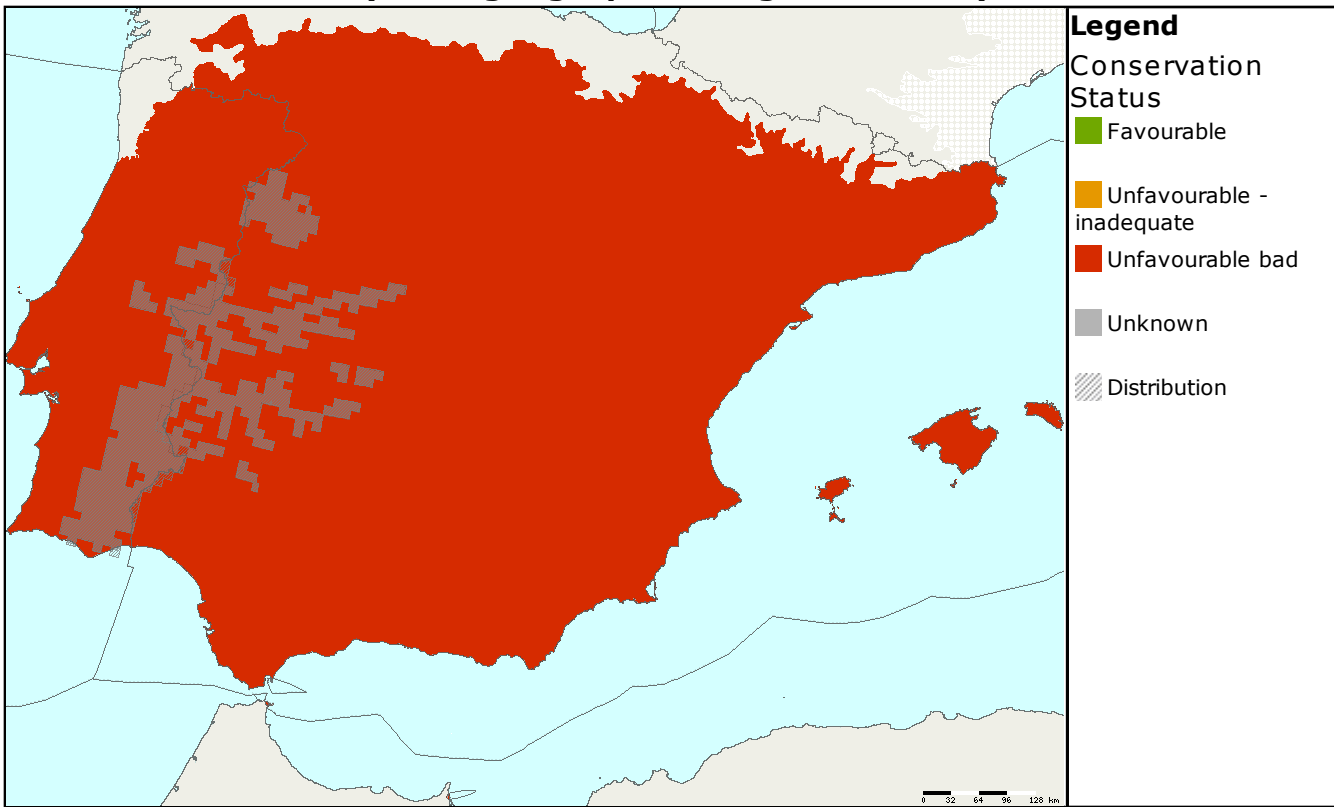

*Rutilus lemmingii* is a species of ray-finned fish endemic to a few river basins in Spain and Portugal in the Mediterranean region. The overall status of conservation for the species is "unfavourable-bad", with all parameters reported as "unfavourable" but the range reported as "favourable" by Portugal. Current valid scientific name is *Iberochondrostoma lemmingii* (Steindachner, 1866)
