



A freshwater fish species nowadays occurring mainly in subalpine lakes in German and Austrian Alps. Small population is known as well from Austrian section of Danube. It is a lentic species occurring in deep waters of lakes.

The conservation status in the Alpine biogeographical region is 'unfavourable inadequate', the status in the Continental biogeographical region is 'unknown'. In the last decades the species was lost from several localities. It is included in the 2008 IUCN Red List in the category 'vulnerable'.
