



Agathidium pulchellum is a very small (under 4 mm) round fungus beetle. It is reported for Boreal biogeographical region by Finland and Sweden. Overall regional assessment is 'unfavourable-inadequate' based on Finnish report (more than 90% of distribution area). Swedish report is 'unfavourable-bad'.
