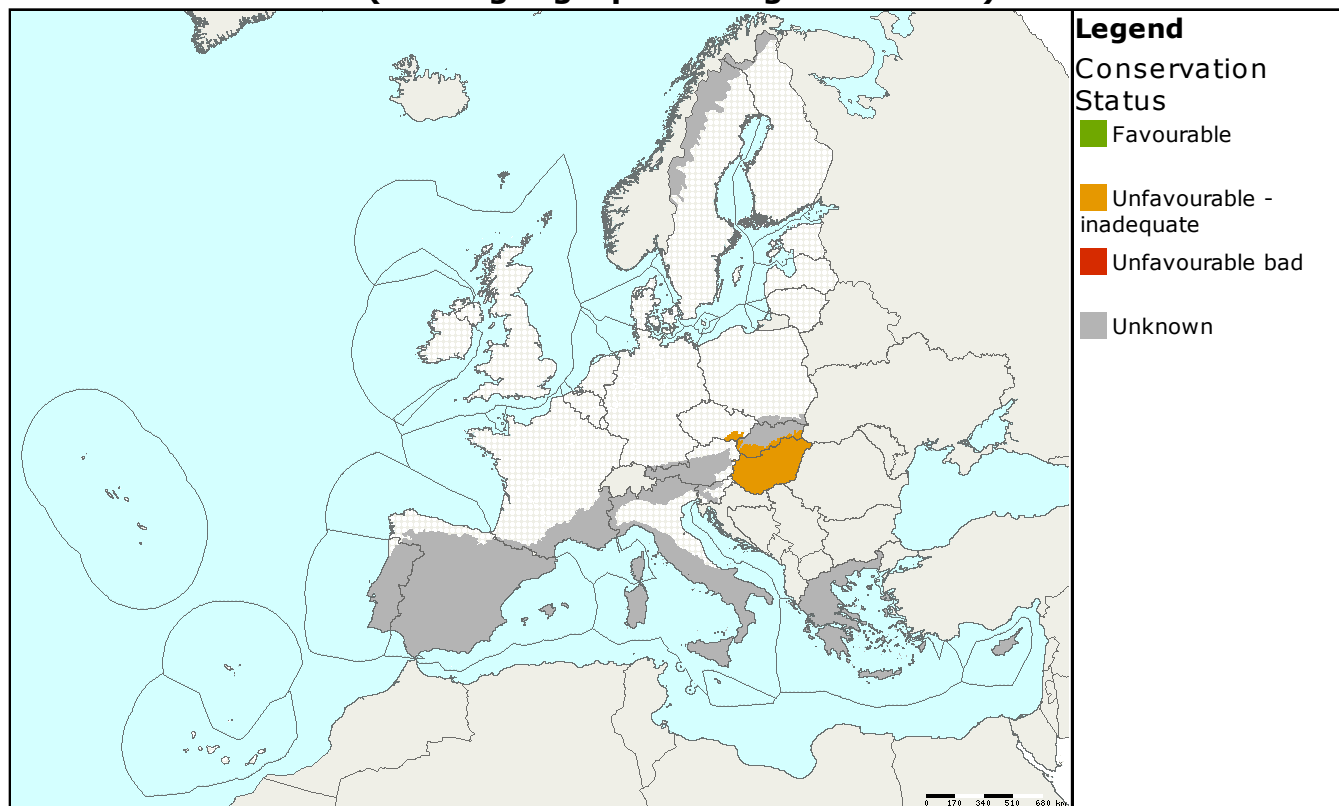

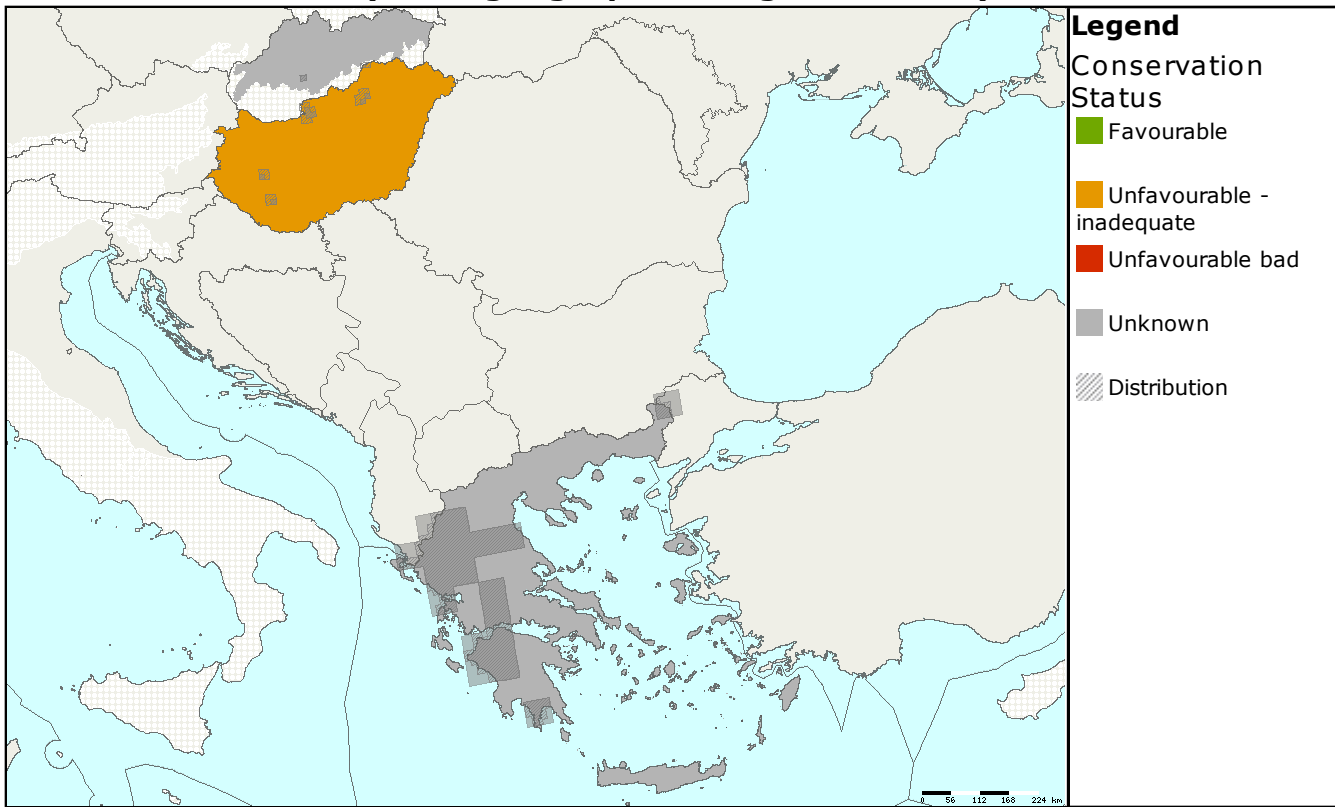

Paracaloptenus caloptenoides is a species of cricket that occurs in Greece, Hungary and Slovakia. For Alpine and Mediterranean regions the species is only reported by Slovakia and Greece, respectively, and the assessment is “unknown” with all parameters reported as “unknown” by both countries, showing that better information is required for this species. Hungary is the only country reporting for Pannonic region and the assessment is “unfavourable-inadequate”.
