



The *Carabus zawadszkii* is a beetle species which occurs in Hungary, Poland and Slovakia. Deficient data from Poland and Slovakia have resulted in an 'unknown' and 'inadequate' overall assessment for the Alpine and Continental region respectively. This beetle species has a considerable amount of its habitat range in Hungary, where it is performing well. This has resulted in a 'favourable' status for the Pannonian region.
