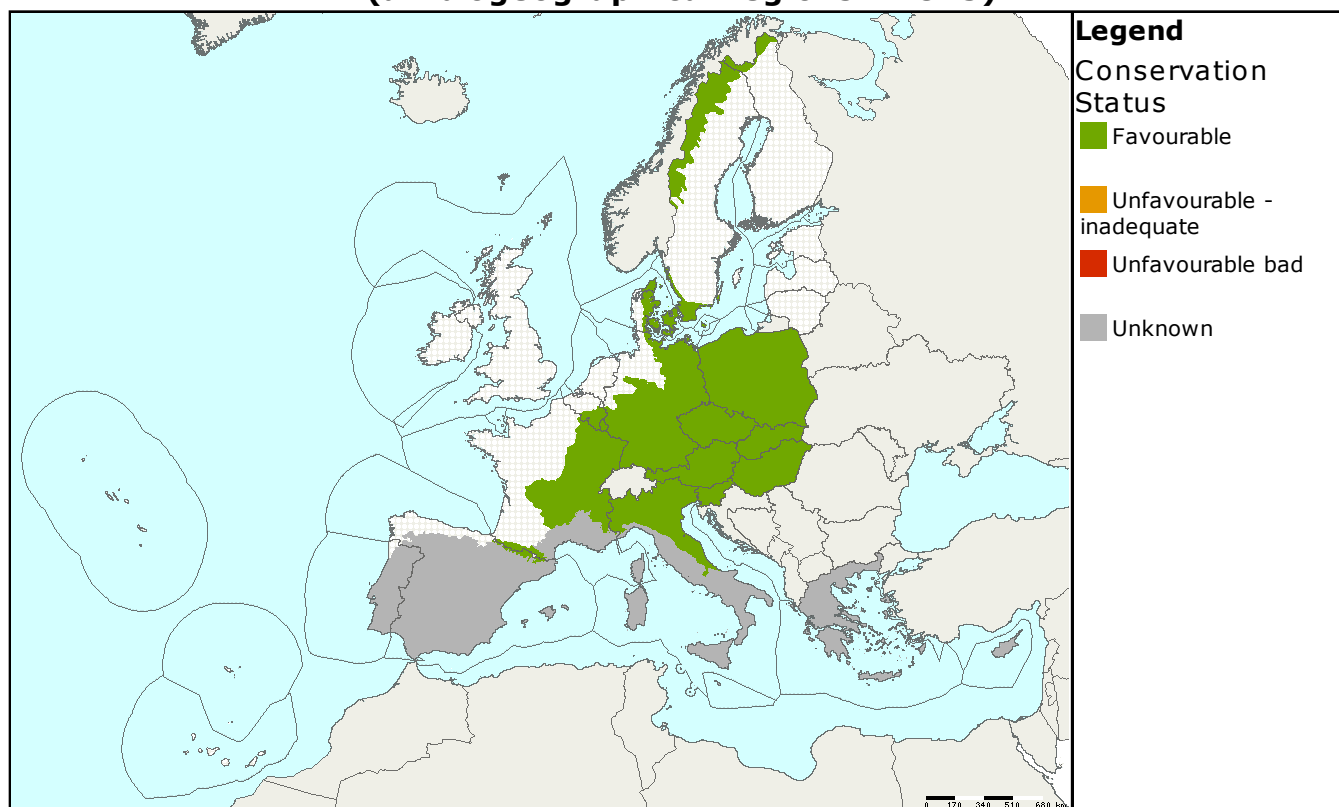

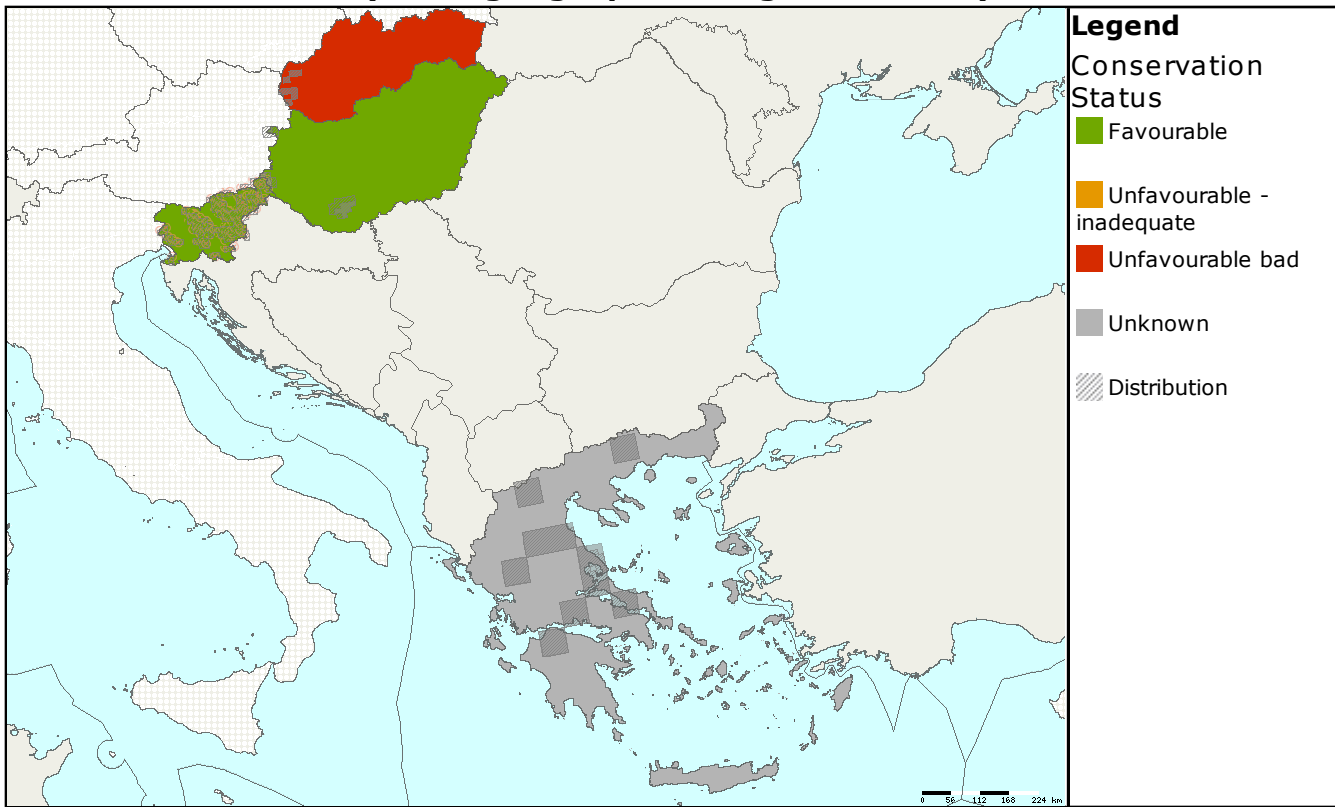

The Balkan golden-ringed dragonfly occurs in some central European countries and Greece.

In three biogeographical regions (Alpine, Continental and Pannonian) the overall status of this species was assessed as 'favourable'. However in Slovakia it was assessed as 'unfavourable-bad'. The status of this species in the Mediterranean biogeographical region was assessed as 'unknown' due to a lack of data from Greece.
