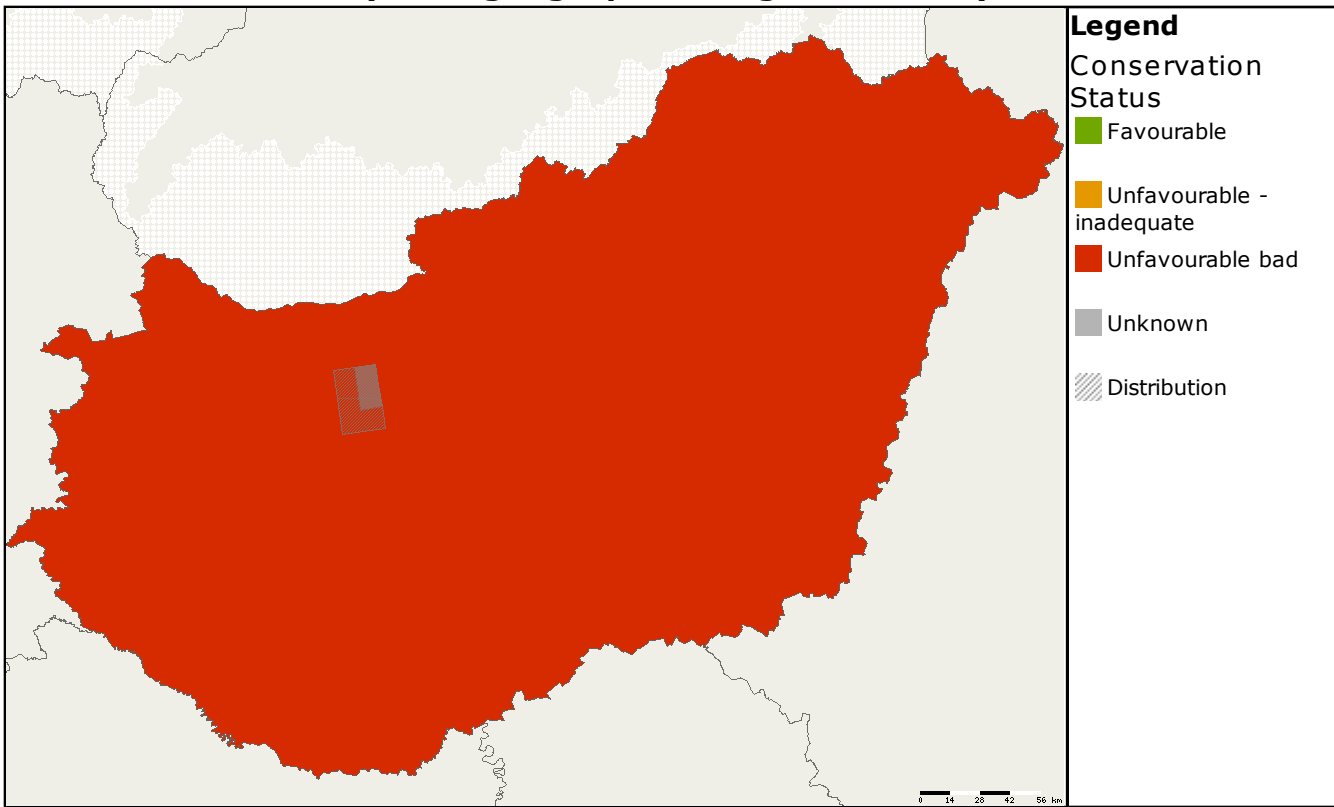

PAN: Species lives in lowland and hilly, open Artemisia-steppes, mostly on sandy or calcareous substrate. The caterpillar feeds on the leaves, later on the flowers of Aster linosyris. It is recorded from Pannonian biogeographical region only from Hungary. Its overall assessment is "bad" because species was evaluated in 2 parameters as "bad".
