



The Corsican Fritillary (Fabriciana elisa) is a butterfly species endemic to Corsica and Sardinia. The species is recorded from the Mediterranean biogeographical region from France and Italy. Its overall regional assessment is 'unfavourable-inadequate'. However, the French report was 'favourable' both in future prospects and overall.
