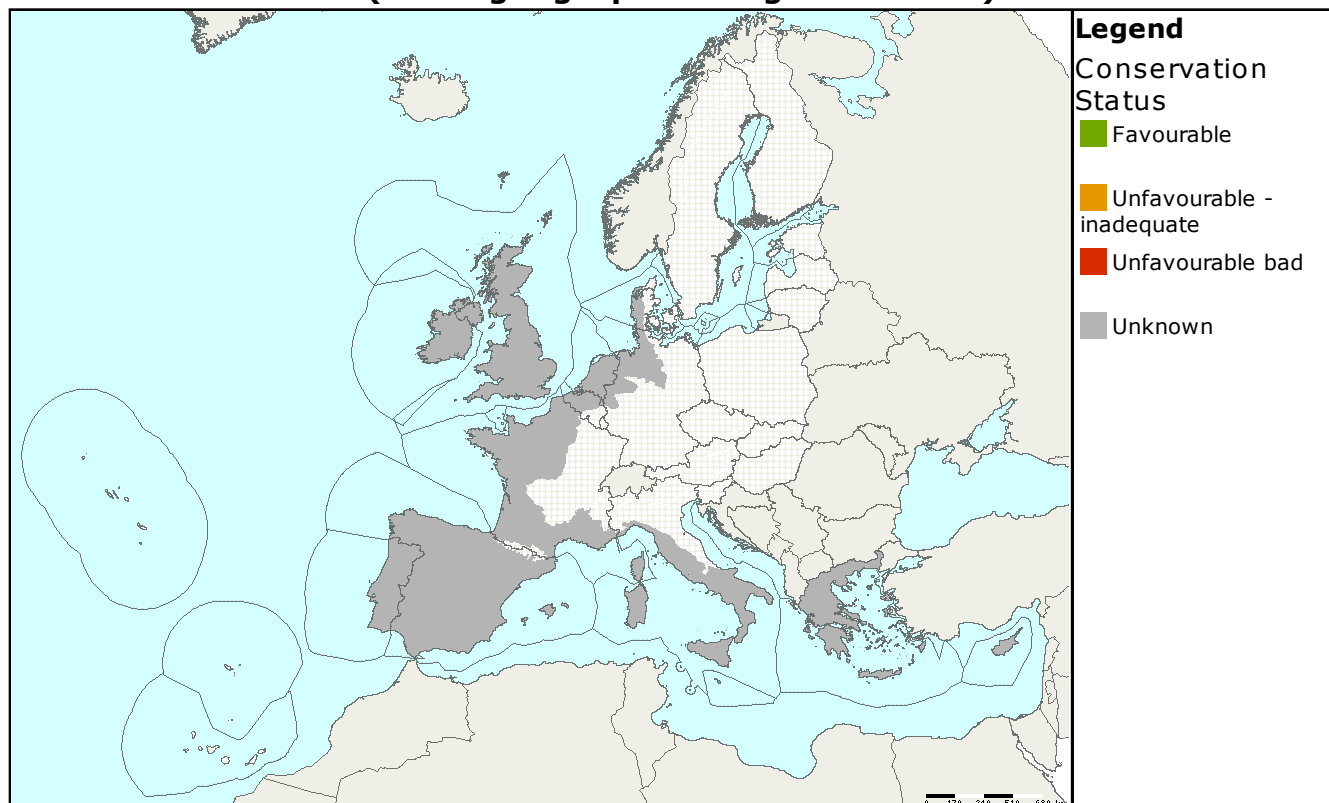

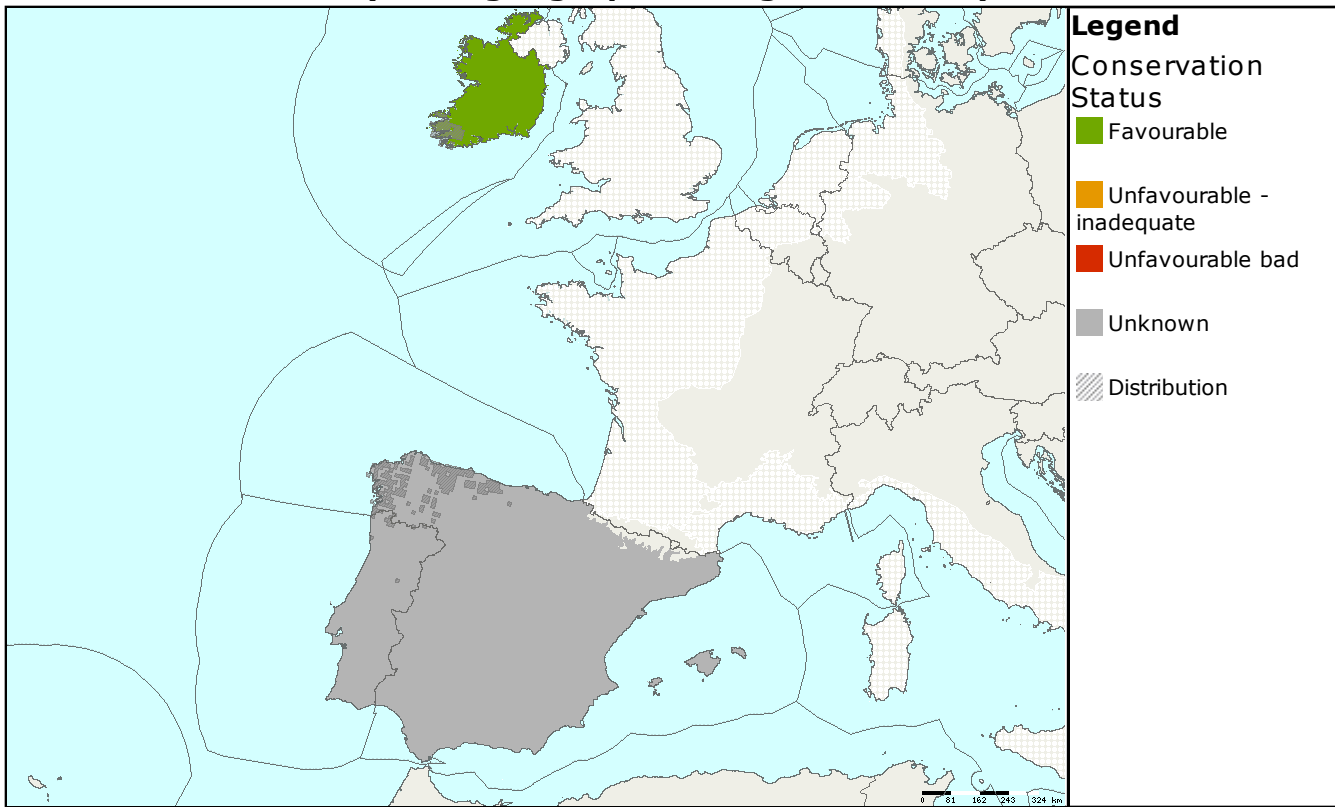

A terrestrial gastropod mollusc occurring in Ireland, Portugal and Spain. The species occurs on wet and dark stands like wet shaded rocks, boulders, fallen tree trunks and others in forest, coastal or even open habitats.

The conservation status in both the Atlantic and the Mediterranean biogeographical regions is 'unknown'. In general the species is very poorly known and better information is required for the comprehensive assessment of the conservation status.
