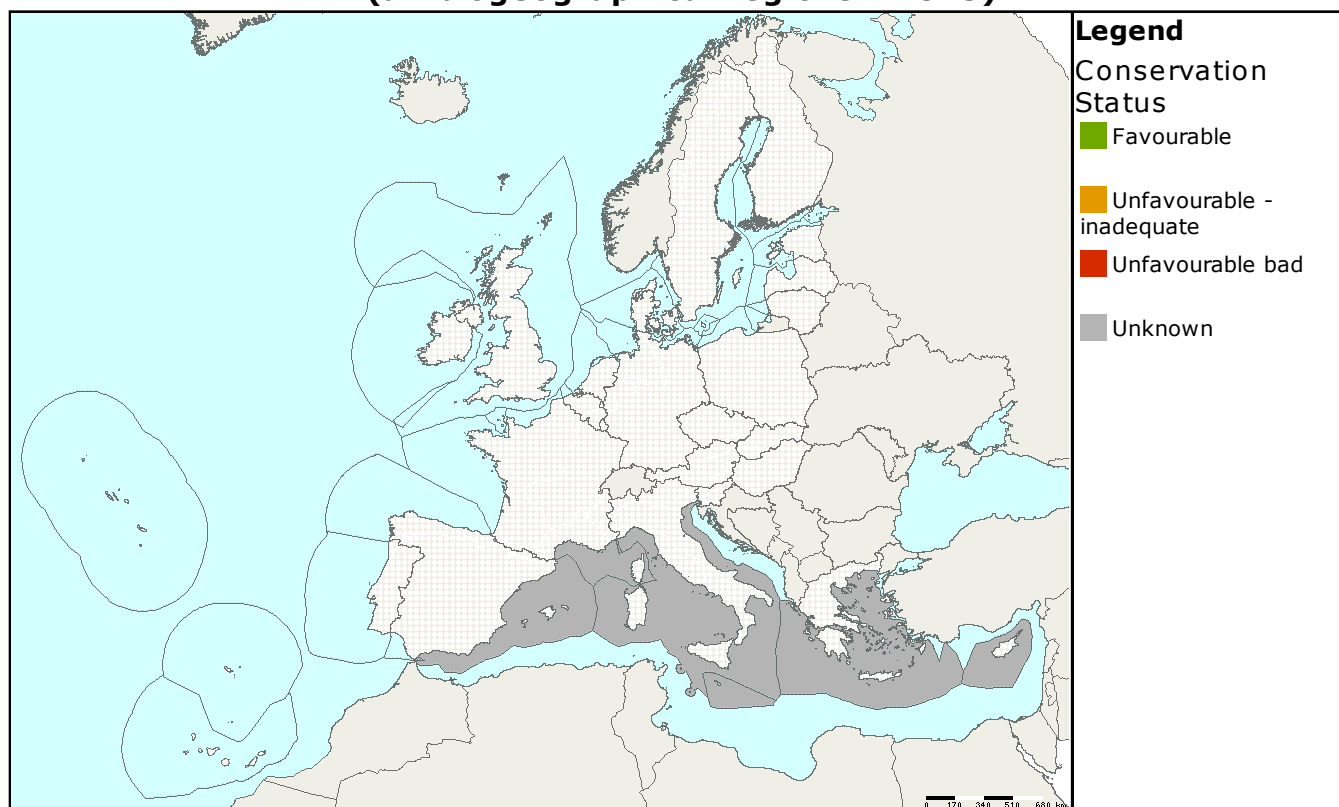

The trochid gastropod *Gibbula nivosa* is endemic to the Maltese Islands. It occurs on seagrass leaves and under rocks at depths of 1-4 meters.

No information on its present status exists, therefore the species' overall assessment is 'unknown'. Because of its very restricted regional distribution and rarity, it is important to collect more data for this species.
