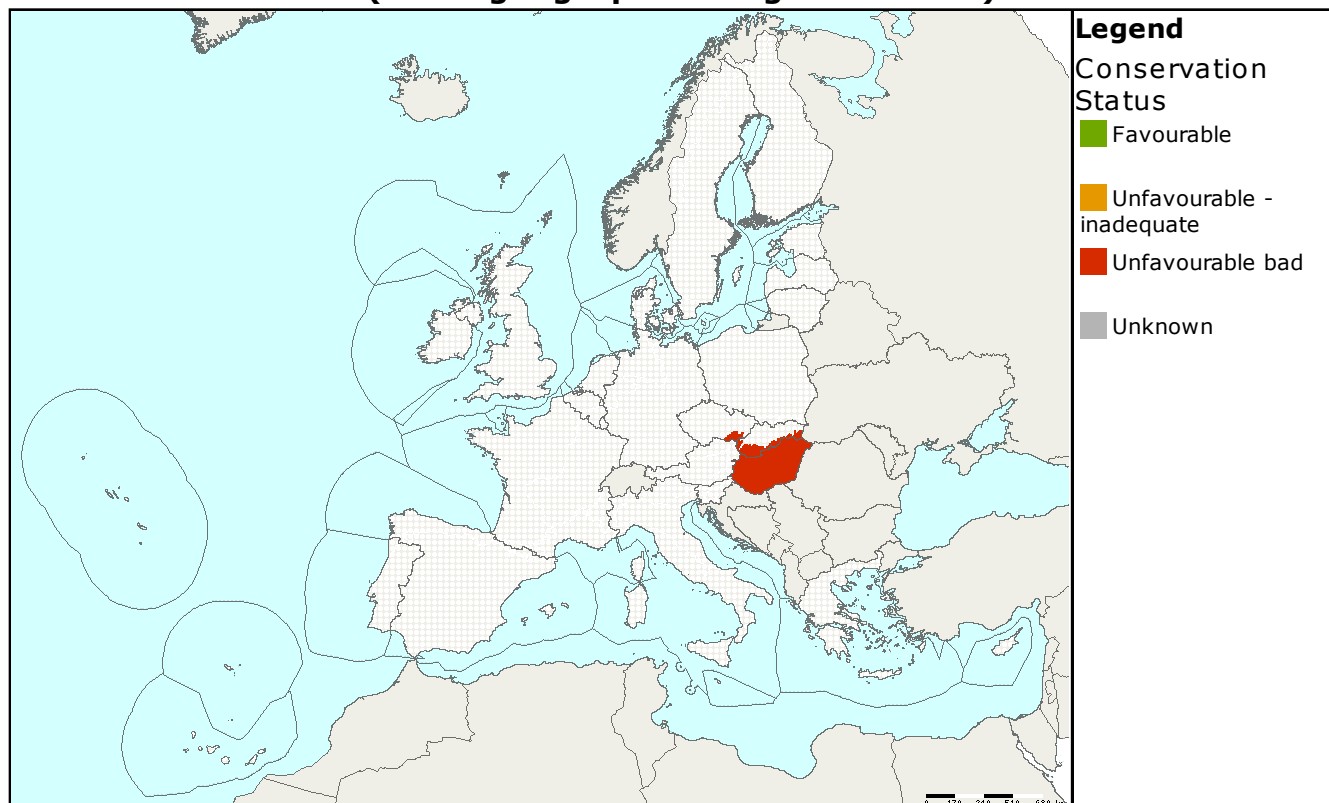

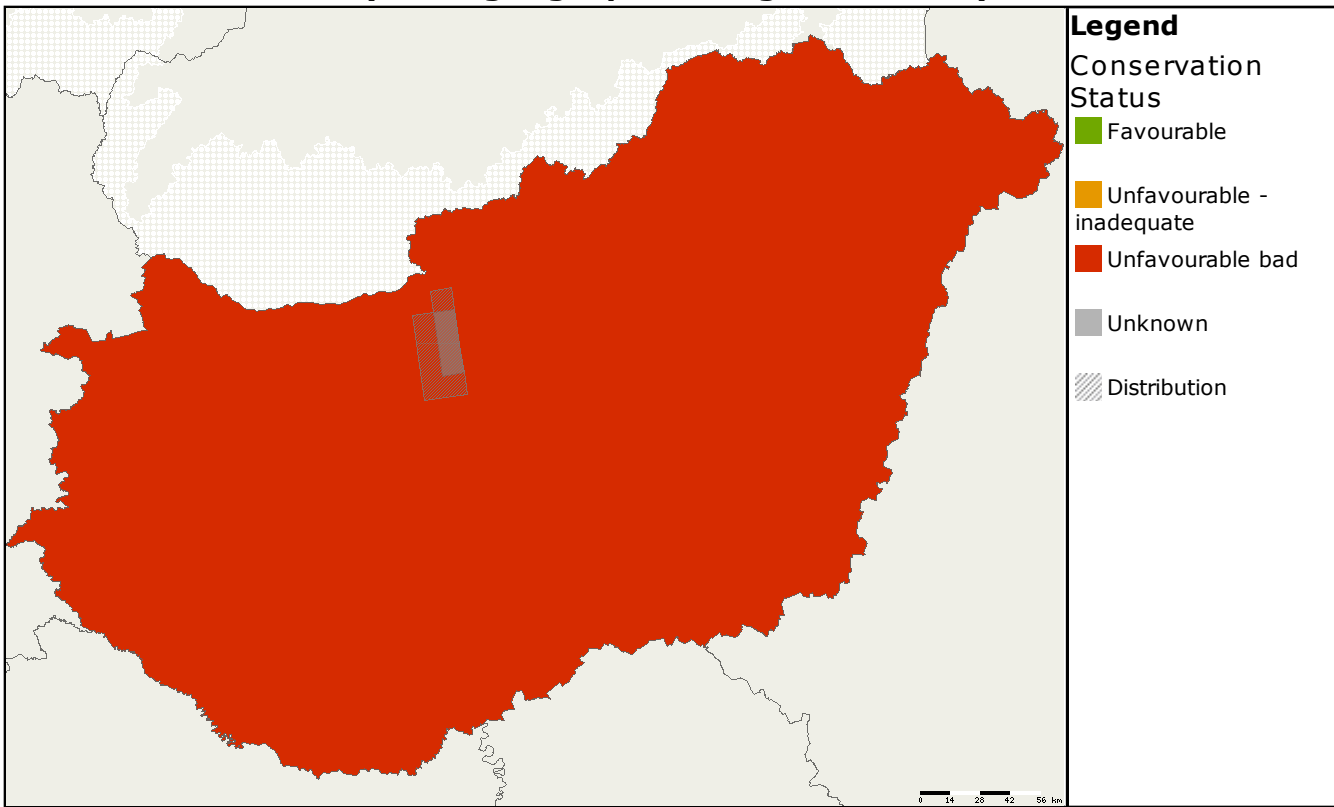

PAN: The species is recorded from the Pannonian biogeographical region only from Hungary. The species is known from three different localities in Budapest, and in another place slightly further to the north, outside from the city border. It has recorded outside Hungary in Transylvania (Romania) and in Serbia. Its habitats are generally the clearings of oak-shrub forest-steppe on calcareous ground. Its overall assessment is "bad" because species was evaluated in all 4 parameters as "bad".
