



The silver-spotted skipper catena (*Hesperia comma catena*) is a butterfly species recorded only from Alpine biogeographical region from Scandinavia (Finland and Sweden). Although assessment for Finland is 'favourable' overall assessment of this species is 'unfavourable-bad' due to its assessment in Sweden being 'unfavourable-bad' in all four parameters. Sweden hosts the majority of its distribution area (66.7%).
