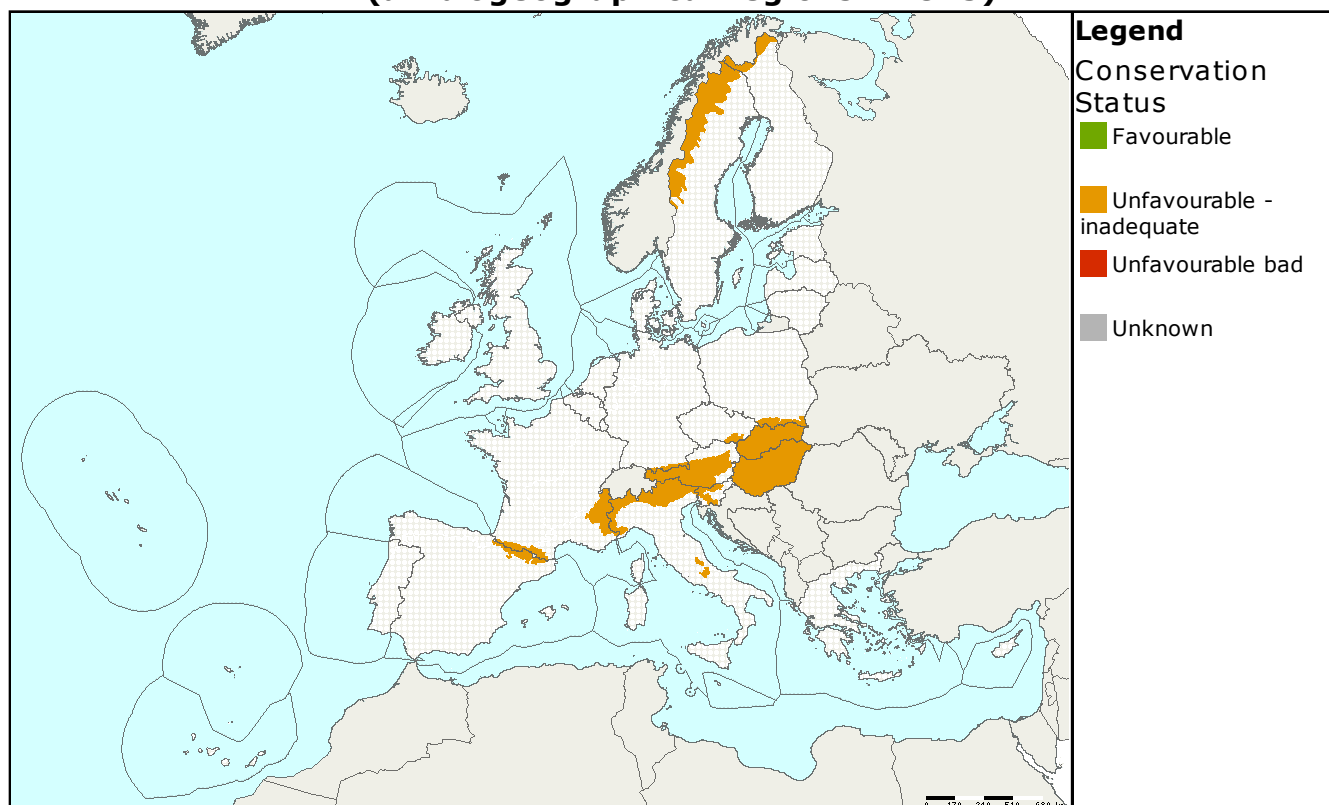

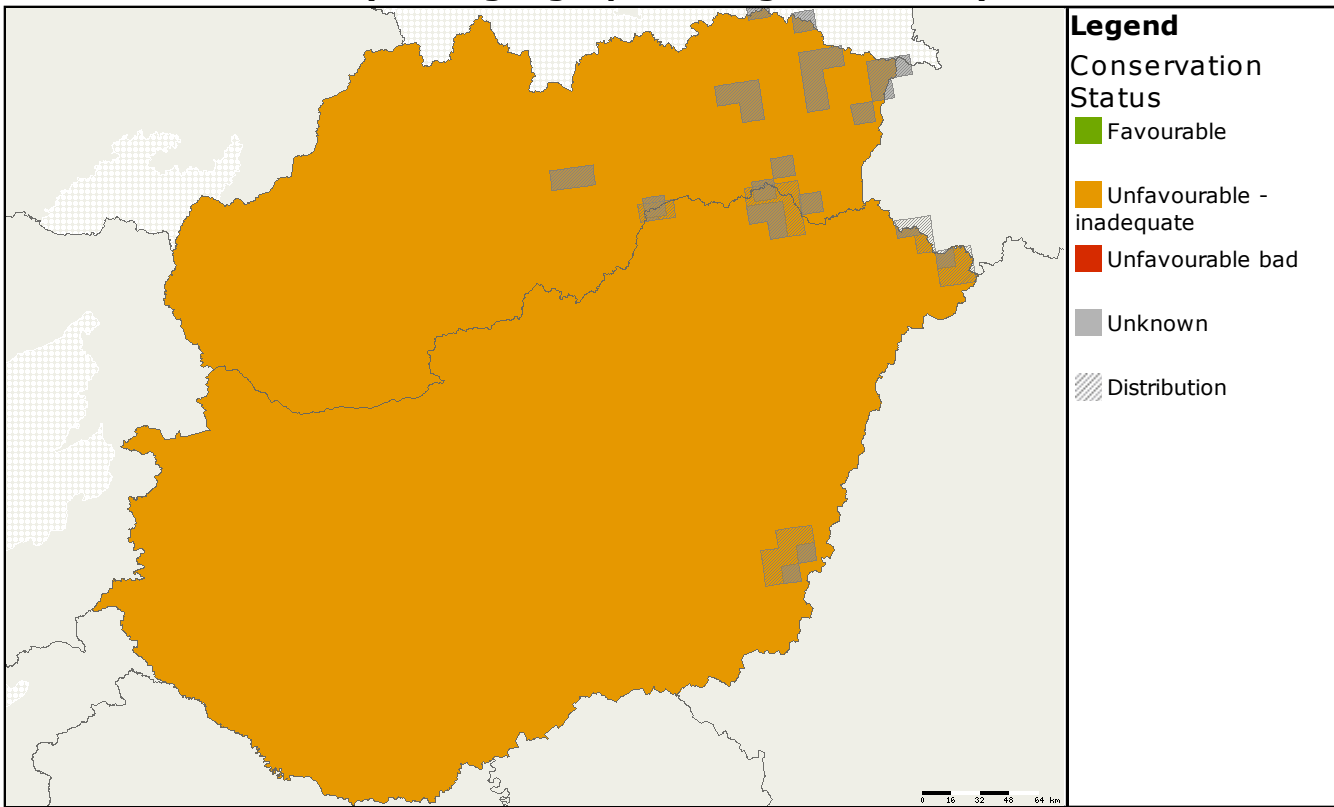

A brachypterous bush-cricket. The centre of the distribution is in the Northern and in the Eastern Carpathians from where the range extends to the neighbouring areas. It occurs in mesophile meadows and tall-herb fringe communities. It prefers stands with dense and tall vegetation.

The conservations status in both the Alpine and the Continental biogeographical regions is 'unfavourable inadequate'. In the Alpine biogeographical region the species is on decline. The Pannonian populations are more or less stable. The habitat of the species is threatened by inappropriate management practices.
