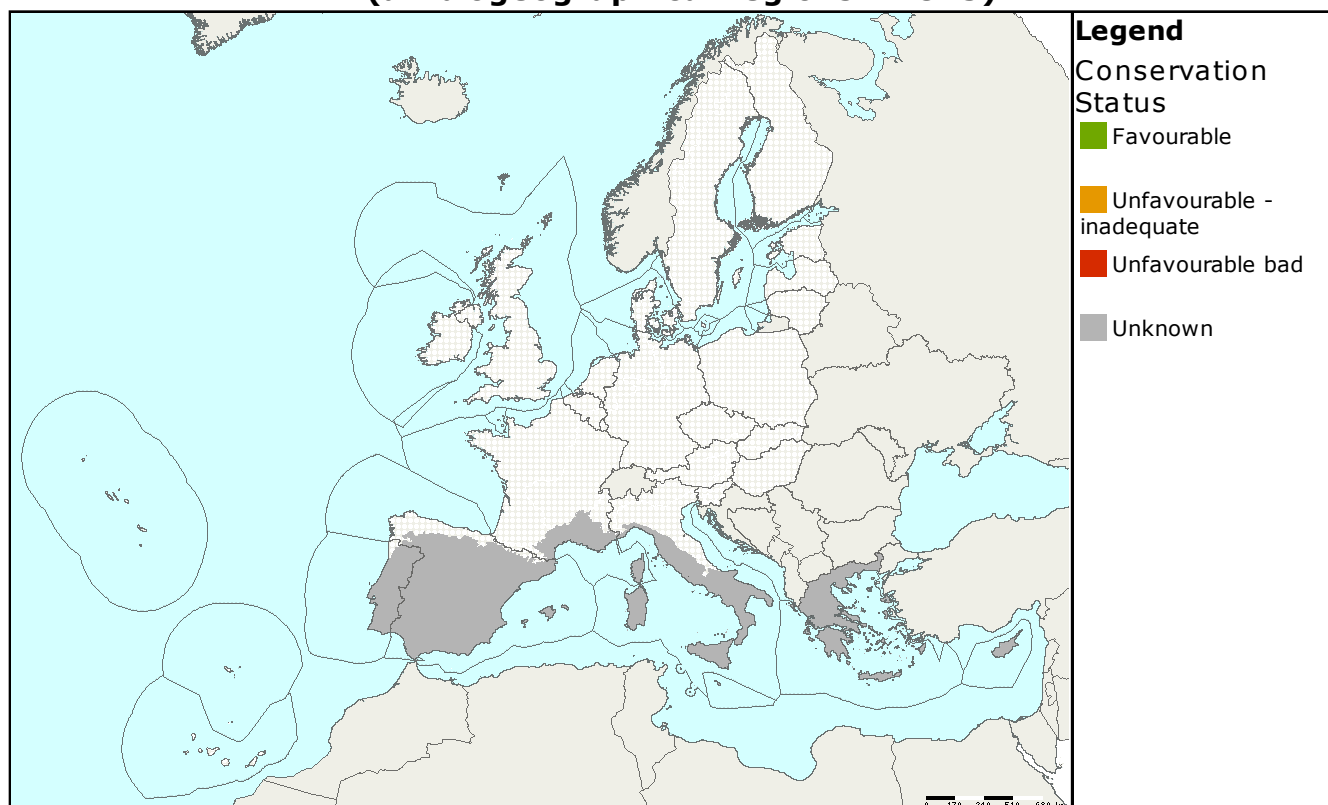

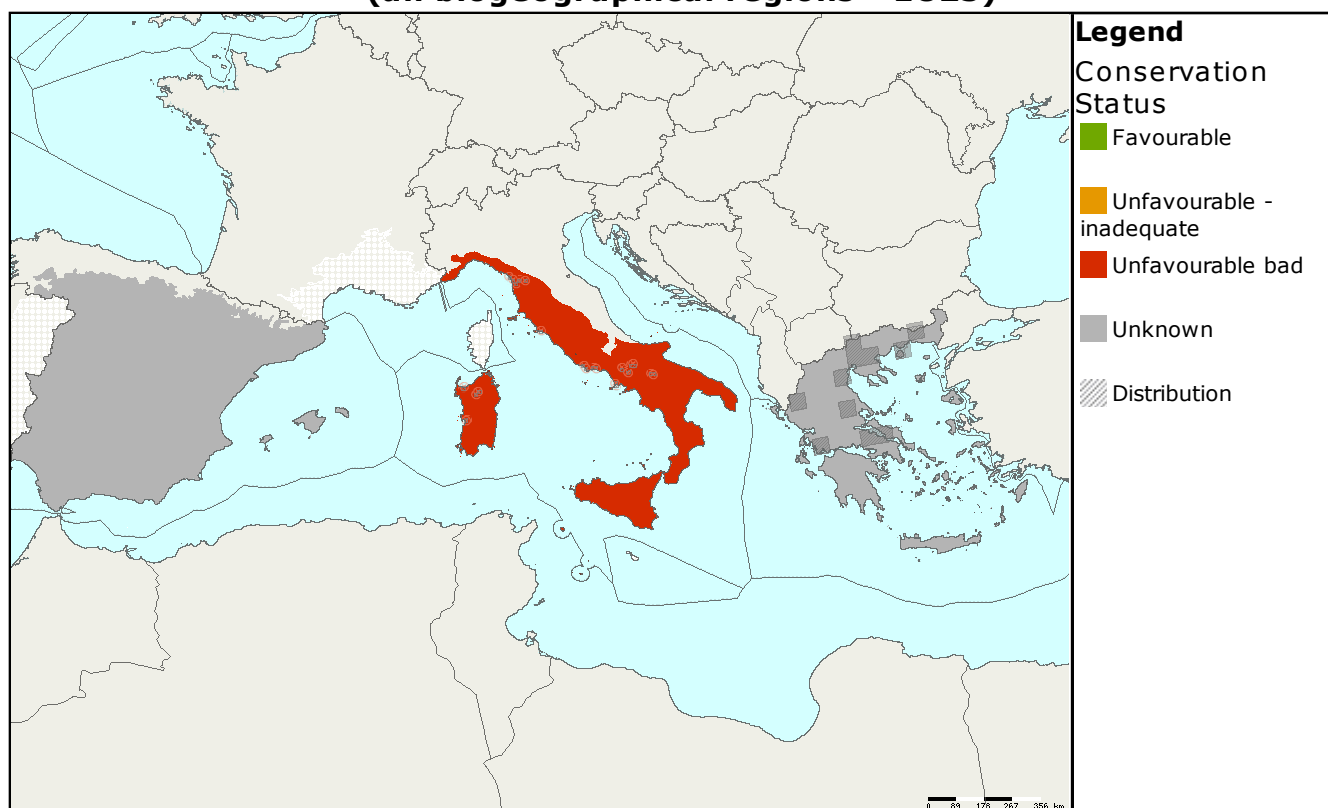

The bladetail (*Lindenia tetraphylla*) is a dragonfly with patchy distribution, mostly in Greece, Montenegro and Turkey, but also in North Africa. Species was reported for Mediterranean region by Greece, Spain and Italy with the majority of distribution area in Greece (more than 90%). Overall assessment is influenced by Greek report resulting 'unknown' conclusion. Most of the data about the species is missing (Greece and Spain), while the Italian report is 'unfavourable-bad'.
