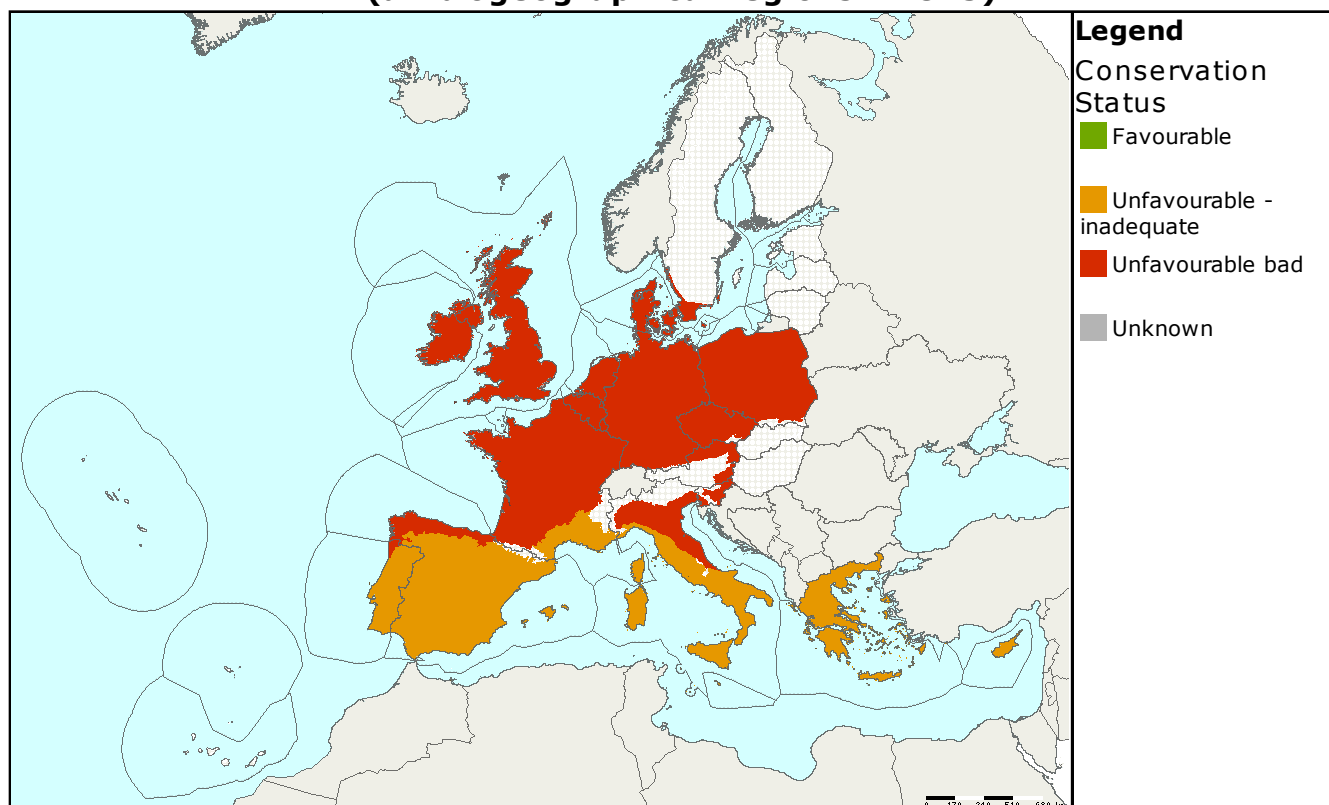

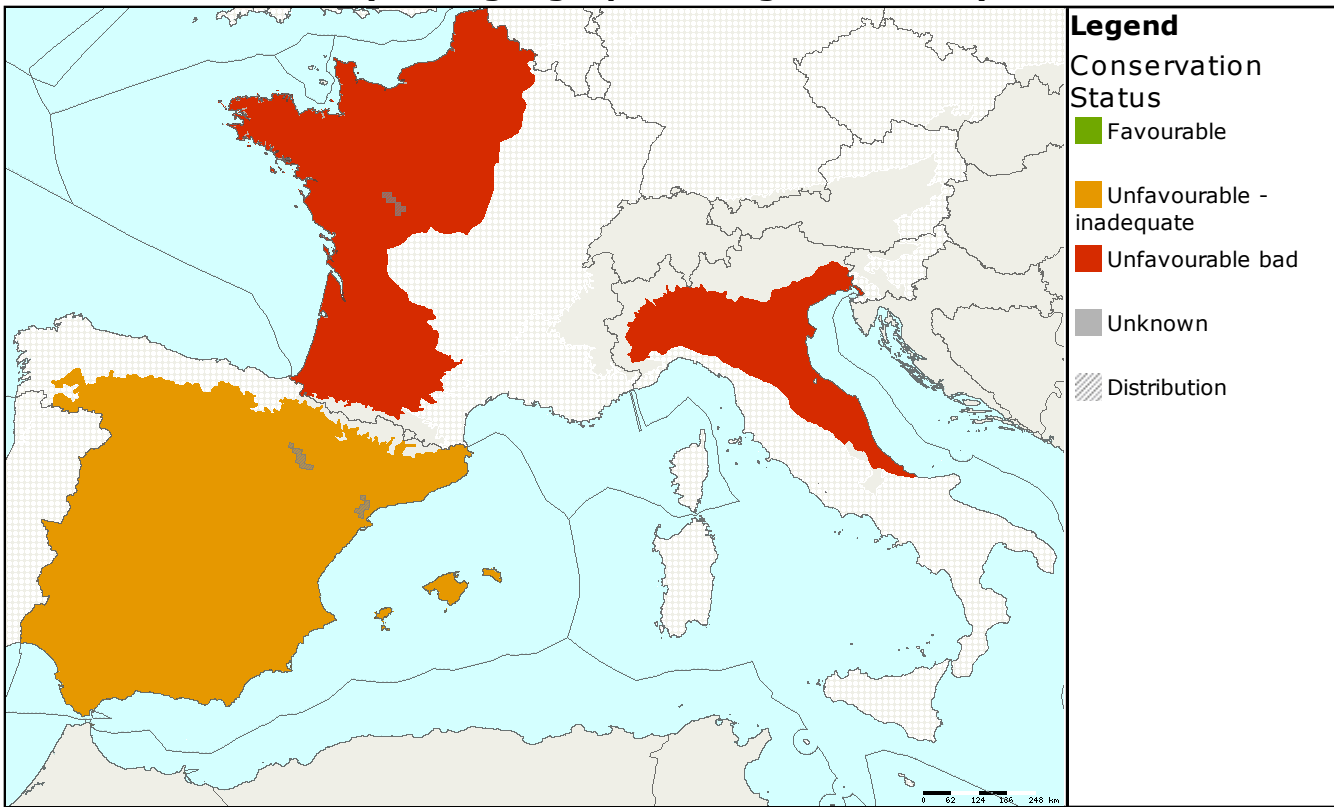

The Spengler's freshwater mussel is an aquatic bivalve mollusc that occurs in Spain, north-eastern Italy and western France. The species status of conservation is reported as "unfavourable-bad" for Atlantic and Continental regions. For the Mediterranean region the overall assessment is "unfavourable-inadequate", despite the significant lack of data. The species is listed as "Critically Endangered" according to IUCN assessment.
