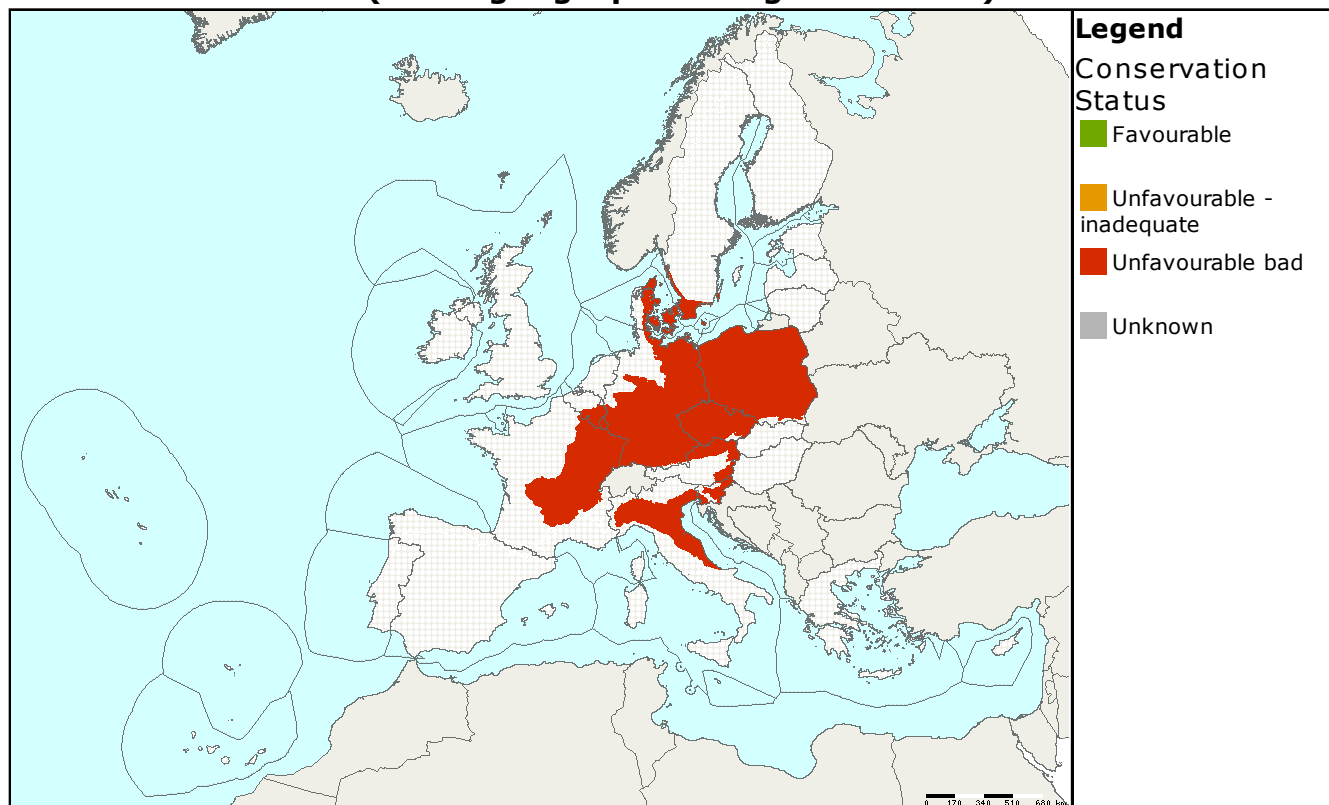

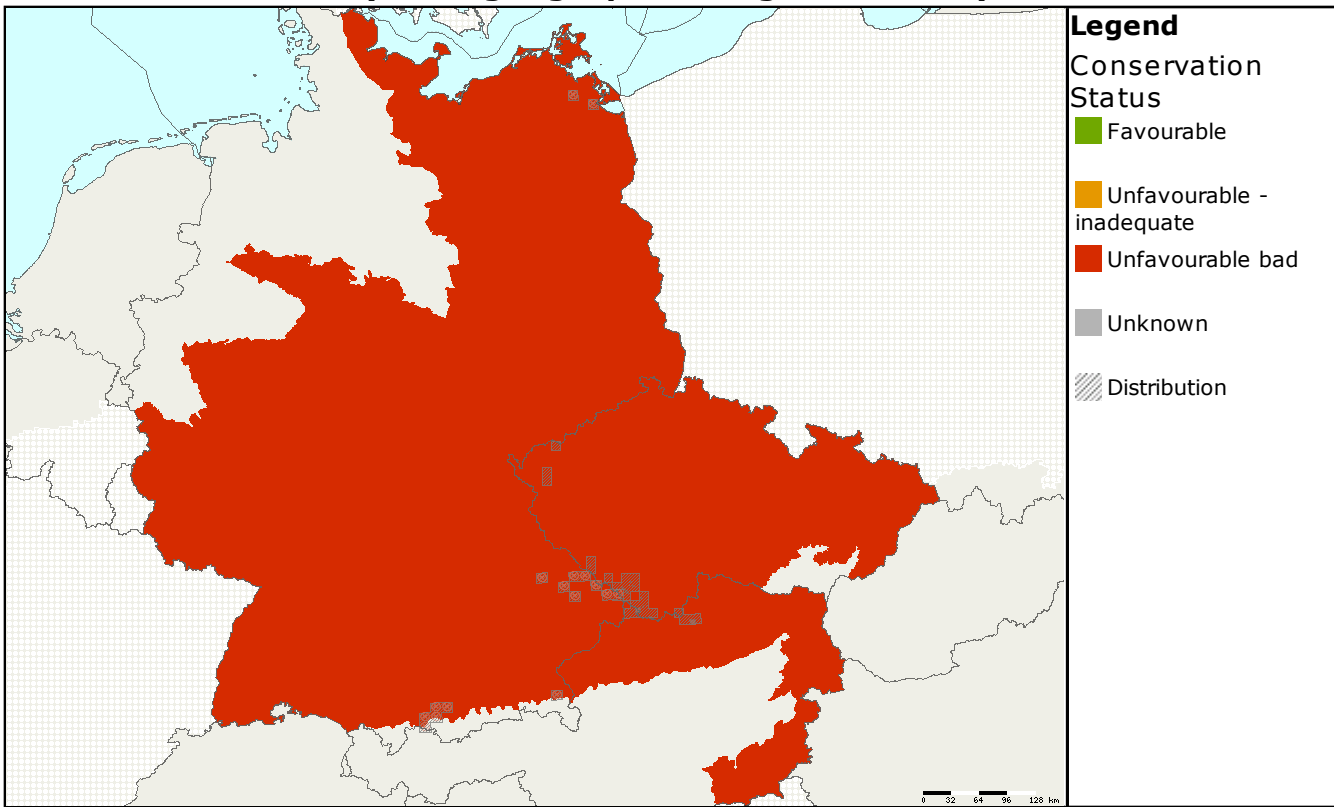

Carabus menetriesi pacholei is a species of beetles found in the continental part of Europe. It was reported in Continental biogeographical region by Austria, Czech Republic and Germany. Overall regional assessment equals all three national reports – ‘unfavourable-bad’.
