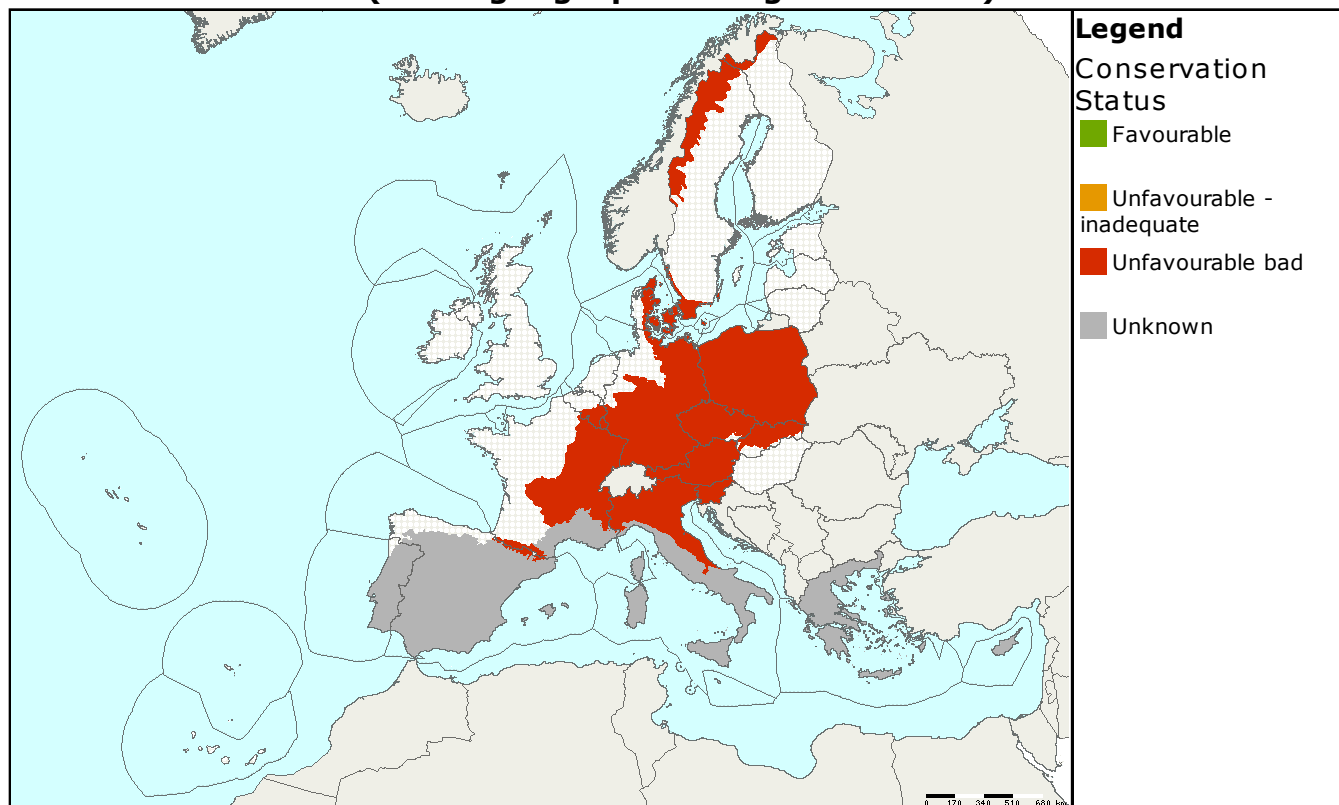

Microcondylaea compressa is an invertebrate species which inhabits Greece, Italy and Slovenia. The largest part of its ranges is in Italy.

The status of this species in the Alpine and Continental region was assessed as ‘bad’. In the Mediterranean region it was assessed as ‘unknown’. The overall assessments were only based the Italian data, since data from Greece and Slovenia were lacking.
