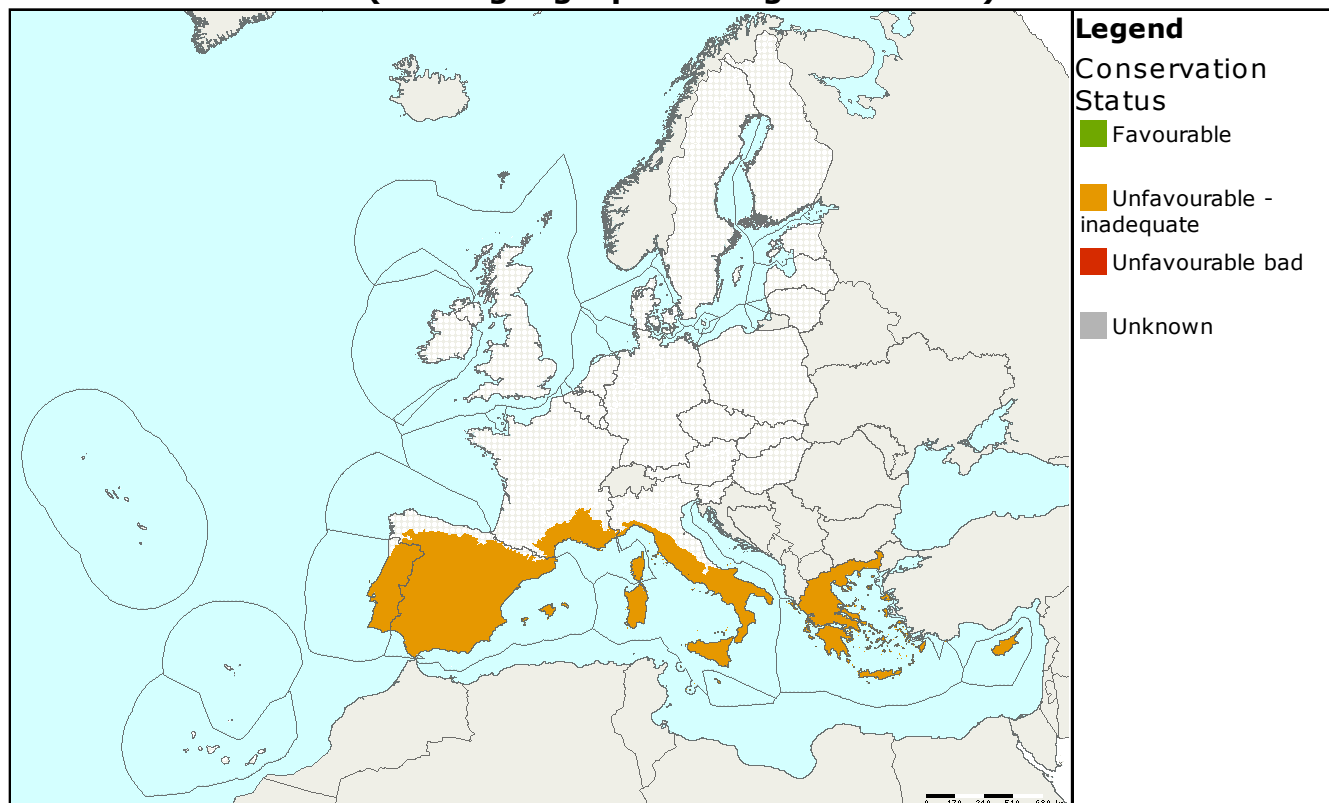

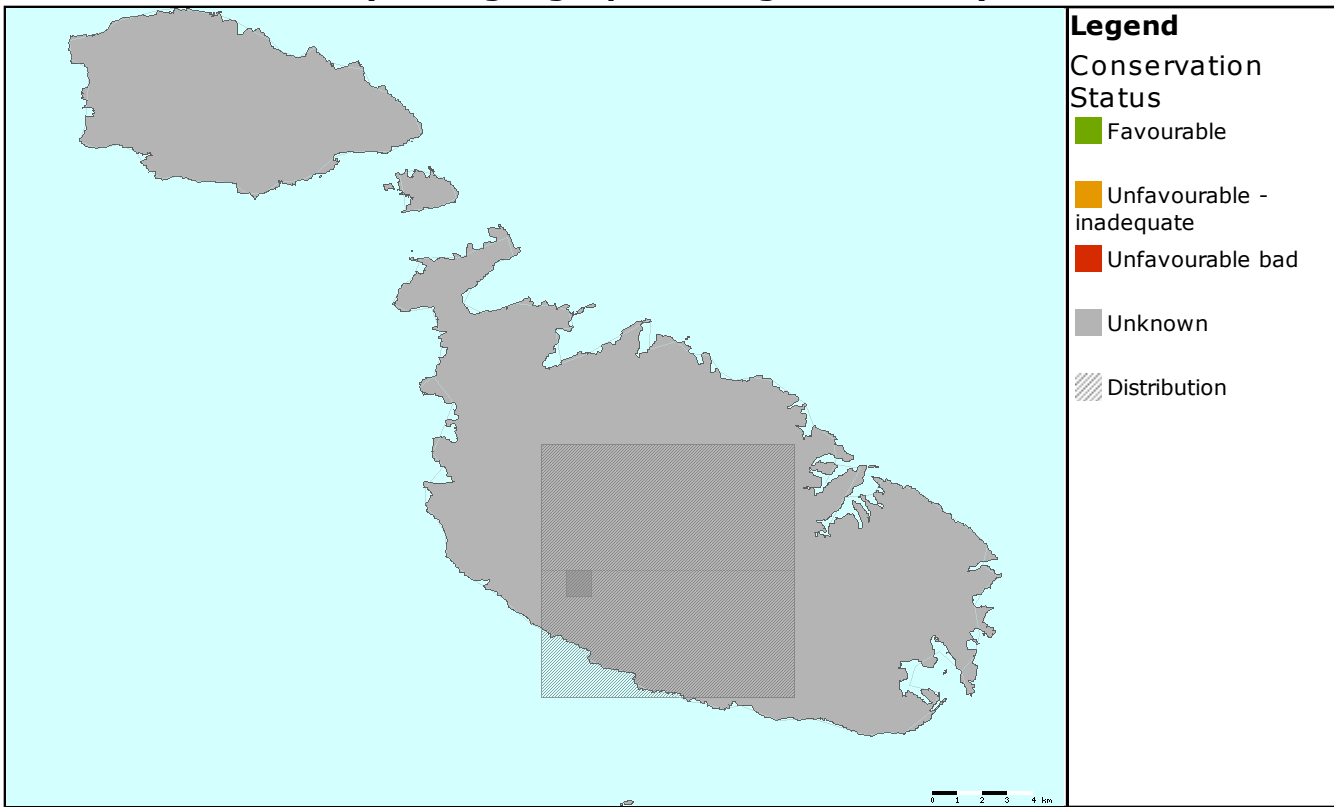

MED: *Myrmecophilus baronii* is a sub-endemic species, which occurs only in a very small area of Malta Island and a low population was recorded. Moreover the reference and trend for range and population are "unknown", neither habitat information is known, therefore the future prospect is not clear at all. However the overall assessment, according to Annex C guidance, is "inadequate".
