



The centre of the distribution of this grasshopper is in the Romanian Carpathians and Transylvania from where the range extends to the neighbouring countries. It occurs in mesophile meadows and bushes mainly in stands with tall dense vegetation.

The conservation status in both the Alpine and the Pannonian biogeographical regions is 'unknown'. However, considering the negative trends and the fact that reported reference values are higher than actual it is possible to conclude, that it is not 'favourable'. The populations in the Hungary and Slovakia represent western margin of the species distribution. The population size is usually limited and the populations are isolated.
