



The Corsican swallowtail occurs only in the islands of Corsica (France) and Sardinia (Italy). The overall assessment for the species is "unfavourable-inadequate" because of the Italian report. All parameters reported by France are assessed as "favourable". The species is listed as "Endangered" by IUCN.
