



PAN: Occurrence of species is reported within the Pannonian region only by Hungary. Assessment of range and habitat resulted into "favourable" status and future prospect is "unknown". Due to assessment of population, which is "inadequate", overall assessment is "inadequate" too, the evaluation of population is not clear and might be changed to "favourable" (positive trend, reference value is the same as top value for size).
