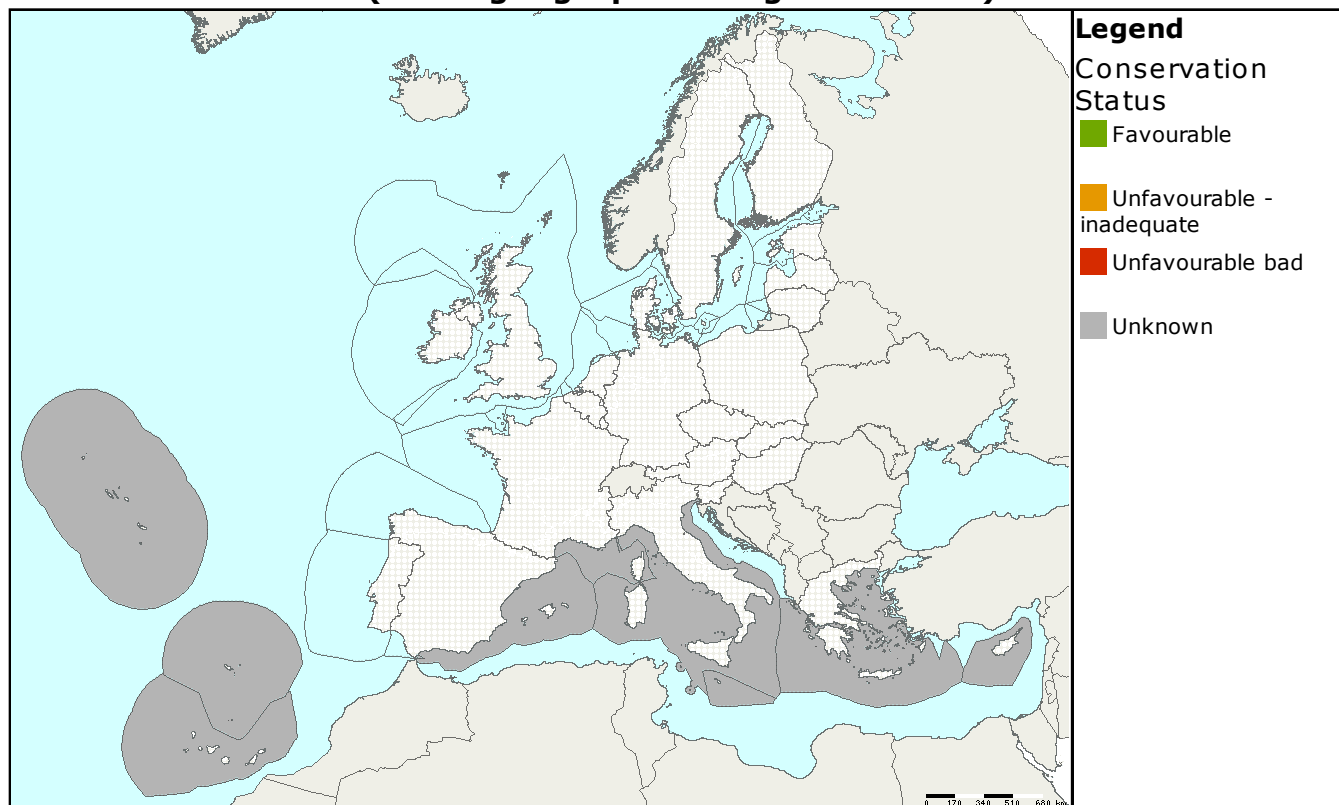

The Mediterranean slipper lobster has a wide distribution range throughout the Mediterranean and Eastern-Central Atlantic. The species has become rare in various areas due to over exploitation. The overall assessment is 'unknown' both in the marine Mediterranean region and in the marine Macaronesian region. All countries report the lack of data for all reporting parameters for the species. This needs to be addressed particularly to inform judgements made to regulate exploitation.
